Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission accepted a Declaration of Vacation and voted unanimously to adopt a resolution consenting to the vacation of the Carmel Bay rights-of-way described in the attached exhibit.

Upon presentation by Attorney James J. Sledge, Attorney for the Black Warrior Solid Waste Authority, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a revised "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN" for Tuscaloosa County for the years 2004 to 2014. This plan, prepared by agents of Tuscaloosa County, was revised in accordance with 22-27-40, Alabama Code and Rule 335-13-9-06 of the Rules and Regulations of the Alabama Department of Environmental Management. Solid Waste Management Plans must be revised and/or updated every ten years under the aforementioned rules and regulations. A notice that a public hearing would be held this morning at this time was run in The Tuscaloosa News.


Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the HAZARDOUS MITIGATION PLAN FOR TUSCALOOSA COUNTY. The plan was completed by the Tuscaloosa County Emergency Management Agency and has been reviewed by FEMA for compliance with federal hazard mitigation planning standards. A copy of this plan is on file in the Probate Office.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to hire the engineering firm of Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. to determine the cost to extend Brookwood Parkway from George Newell Road to Highway 216.

Upon Commissioner Bobby Miller's motion, the County Commission authorized the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department to determine if the City of Tuscaloosa will share in the expense of a study to determine if Hargrove Road East from Skyland Boulevard to Butter-milk Road can be widened, four-laned, etc. in an effort to alleviate traffic congestion on this portion of Hargrove Road East. Commissioner Miller's motion further stated that Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. would be hired to do the study if monies are secured for said study. The portion of Hargrove Road East in question meanders in and out of Tuscaloosa County and the City of Tuscaloosa seven times.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 25, 2004.





**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STREETS IN


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION:
