This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the County Engineer's selection of the following firms as low bidders meeting specifications on road projects that were bid on August 4, 2004:

JOHN SWINDLE ROAD BASE PROCESSING
Mallory Burkhalter Paving, Inc.

OLD FAYETTE ROAD AND GRAHAM ROAD EARTHWORK & CONSTRUCTION
Tomlin Construction LLC

BLUE RIDGE DRIVE EARTHWORK & CONSTRUCTION
Tomlin Construction LLC (One bid was received, and the bid was negotiated down to \$59,071 in return for extending the starting date 30 days)

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award

the bid for transverse joint grinding on County Road 140 to S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc., the only bidder. The bids were opened on August 18, 2004.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for base processing on Murk Montgomery Road to Mallory Burkhalter Paving, Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications. The other bidder was S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc. The bids were opened on August 18, 2004.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve Druid City Bicycle Club's application for the county's Adopt-A-Mile Program. They intend to remove litter from the rights-of-way of Sanders Ferry Road from Black Warrior Parkway to Black Warrior Road.

Exhibit 8-5, Pages 335-336

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to resurface 51st Avenue at a cost of approximately \$30,000 to Tuscaloosa County. Heavy (loaded) trucks have damaged this street.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to estimate the cost to pave the school bus parking lot at the Tuscaloosa County School Transportation Shop. The County Engineer will report back to the County Commission.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution vacating the right-of-way (Old Chigger Ridge Road) described in the attached exhibit.

Upon request from the City of Northport, and upon motion by Commissioner Mike Richardson, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission authorized the Planning Department to seek a 2005 Enhancement Grant. Northport will use this grant to restore and preserve a span of the original metal bridge that crossed the Black Warrior River between Northport and the City of Tuscaloosa. This bridge span, constructed in the 1880's, is presently located on Dellert Farm Road off of Hwy 43 N in Northern Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the submission of an Appalachian Regional Commission grant application in the amount of \$24,000. This \$24,000 and the \$24,000 required match will be used to study the existing water and sewer facilities within Tuscaloosa County and to develop a plan for possible future expansion.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Planning Department to notify Warrior River Water Authority to proceed with construction bids for the Prudes Creek North Water Extension Project. This project will provide water service to approximately ninety families in Tuscaloosa County and fifty-two families in Jefferson County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution awarding the contract for the construction of the

Holt Community Sanitary Sewer Extension Project, Phase II, to the low bidder, Gilco Contracting Company, Inc. in the amount of \$903,451.53.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the months of June and July, 2004.

Exhibit 8-9, Pages 341-342

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant developer Buddy Jones a waiver of Tuscaloosa County's subdivision regulations Rule 5-3-11 for Shades Creek Estates Subdivision. Rule 5-3-11 limits cul-de-sac length to a maximum of 600 feet. The cul-de-sac length for this subdivision is approximately 6,700 feet and provides an access road for lots that are in excess of five acres in size.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum to execute a \$129,459.30 Court Referral Officer Contract with the State Administrative Office of Courts. Under this one year (October 1, 2004, through September 30, 2005) contract, Tuscaloosa County will hire and supervise court referral officers in Tuscaloosa and Bibb Counties; provide evaluation, referral and placement for defendants who are referred by Judges; and provide case management, monitoring, drug testing, etc. This is a continuation contract.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Louis N. Lambert to the Carrolls Creek Water Authority. Mr. Lambert's new term began on March 1, 2003, and will expire on March 1, 2009.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint

Sammie Anders to the Sand Springs Water Authority, Inc. Mr. Anders' new term began on March 1, 2003, and will expire on March 1, 2009.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Tuscaloosa County Park and Recreation Authority to prepare plans and seek bids on a 5.6 million dollar multipurpose athletic and community center to be constructed adjacent to the new Taylorville Primary School at Hinton Park off of Alabama Hwy 69 South. This proposed facility will combine athletic facilities with conference and meeting rooms and possibly a library branch, and will provide programs for preschool age through senior citizen activities. The low bid must be presented to the County Commission for approval prior to the awarding of same. The Planning Department will attempt to secure state and/or federal grants for this project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer, in conjunction with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation, to determine the best and most feasible route for a road from U.S. Hwy 82 to South Rosser Road.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Planning Department to compile data and pursue grant monies in preparation for the Dry Creek Sewer Project.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to hire the engineering firm of Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. to work in conjunction with the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department and Planning Department to identify the best route for a new road from U.S. Hwy 82 to County Road 2 and determine the best of two alternatives: construction of a new road or improvement of County Road 2.


Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution in which Tuscaloosa County accepts two 5-ton air conditioning units, two 5-ton air handlers, and all ductwork, wiring, labor, materials, and permits necessary for installation of same at the Tuscaloosa Metro Animal Shelter. Funds for this project have been donated by a group of volunteers for the animal shelter.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 1, 2004.





Attached is a preliminary layout of a proposed subdivision by Mr. Buddy Jones as developer. CFM Layton is the company handling the design and engineering for this project and is being represented by Mr. Jeremy Pike. The proposed subdivision is located in District 2 and on the West side of the Holt Lock and Dam Road.

The proposed road will have a length of approximately 6,700 feet (1.27 miles). The lot sizes are all above 5.0 acres, thus exempting them from the City of Tuscaloosa's subdivision requirements.

- 1) The requirement that any cul-de-sac to be constructed must be less than 600 feet in total length.

Rule 5-3-11 states in regards to cul-de-sacs, "... shall not be more than 600 feet in length unless approved by the County Commission for specific reasons of topography or other practical difficulties."
