This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented Equipment Operator III Robert Hagler a thirty year service pin and thanked Mr. Hagler for his long service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on the Prudes Creek Basing and Paving Project to the low bidder meeting specifications. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve Change

Order Number One for the "Southwest Tuscaloosa Project" portion of the County-wide Water Expansion Program. This change order reduces the contract price by \$36,566.93.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted three to one not to apply for a \$3,000 State of Alabama Agriculture Department grant on behalf of the Tuscaloosa County Board of Education. These grant funds are restricted to agricultural (landscaping, ground maintenance, etc.) related activity. The County Commission was concerned about the lack of guidelines and/or regulations in regard to the distribution of said funds. Commissioner Gary Youngblood, citing the landscaping needs of some of the schools, cast the NAY vote.

Upon recommendation by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to settle a lawsuit filed by Marcia Denton for \$7,500. Ms. Denton had an automobile accident when her vehicle hit a washout on Keene's Mill Road.

Upon request from the County Attorney, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session to discuss the Willie Gordon lawsuit regarding the last election. Mr. Gordon contends that Tuscaloosa County should have drawn new County Commission district lines prior to the June 1, 2004, primary election using the most current (year 2000) census data to make the voting population substantially equal in each voting district. The present district lines were drawn using 1990 census data.



There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 6, 2004.

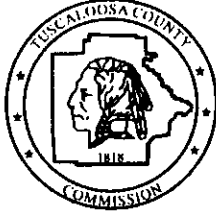




WHEREAS, said Tuscaloosa County Commission does hereby find:


That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency;
