This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Reginald Murray

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 25 MPH speed limit on Wesley Chapel Road from Mount Carmel CME Church to the end of Wesley Chapel Road.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to enter into an agreement with the State of Alabama, acting by and through the Alabama Department of Transportation, for resurfacing on County Road 140 from State Road 6 near Coker to the Pickens County line (Project #ST-063-888-033, TCP 63-16-01).

County Engineer Bobby Hagler reported that S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc. was awarded the contract for base processing on Old Jasper Road as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened October 6, 2004.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to negotiate with the single bidder for steel pilings. The bidding firm was as follows:

Accounting Director Bill Lamb presented the County Commission with the first draft of projected revenues for fiscal year 2004-2005.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay the Trott family \$3,500 for sufficient right-of-way on Richard Street to facilitate improvement to said street.

Upon request by Sheriff Ted Sexton, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to reject the "Oil Change" bids for Sheriff's Office vehicles because the bids were too high. The bids were opened October 6, 2004.

Bids for "Oil Changes" for Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Office vehicles were opened and referred to the Sheriff's Office for appropriate action. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for "Detention Facility Supplies" to ATD America Company as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened September 15, 2004.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bids for "Kitchen Equipment for the Tuscaloosa County Jail", which were opened October 6, 2004, as follows:

- Gas Convection Oven - Cooks Correctional Kitchen Equipment
- Gas Restaurant Range - Cooks Correctional Kitchen Equipment
- Ice Machine - Cooks Correctional Kitchen Equipment
- Heavy Duty Disposer - Cooks Correctional Kitchen Equipment
- Tray Assembly Line - Leroy's Food Service Equipment
- Dishwasher - Leroy's Food Service Equipment

Tuscaloosa County Board of Education Superintendent Frank Costanzo introduced members of the County Board of Education James Junkins, James Barnett, Morris Acker, Frankie Thomas, Dot Smith, Don Presley, and Pam Garner; and made a slide presentation explaining how \$32 million raised by the three-year one cent sales tax was expended. The monies raised were spent on construction of new schools and classroom additions, eliminating one hundred and seventeen portable classrooms. The revenues were expended on construction of new schools and classroom additions at Northside High School, Brookwood Elementary School, Davis-Emerson Middle School, Hillcrest High School, Hillcrest Middle School, Maxwell Elementary School, and Westwood Elementary School. The construction fund has a present balance exceeding \$1 million.

Upon request by the Tuscaloosa County Board of Education, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Tuscaloosa County Board of Education to expend the balance of \$1,102,462 in the construction funds to meet critical maintenance needs of the county school system, which will include roof repairs on seven school buildings - Holt High Vocational School; Sprayberry Education Center; and Matthews, Cottondale, Huntington Place, Holt, and Crestmont Elementary Schools.


Mr. Willie Pruitt presented the Commission a petition containing forty-three signatures requesting improvements to Shady Hill Road in the Rice Valley area.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Attorney to proceed with the condemnation of Ms. Warine Martin Hall's property on Water Tower Road to facilitate improvements to said road.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Donnel S.D. Williams to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation Board of Bibb, Pickens, and Tuscaloosa Counties Inc. to fill the position left vacant by the death of Dr. Joyce Sellers. The term for this position will expire April, 2008.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Tuesday, November 9, 2004.

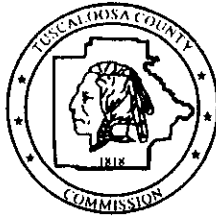


