TUSCALOOSA COUNTY §  
STATE OF ALABAMA §

Prior to convening the County Commission meeting, Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum administered the oath of office to the four County Commissioners who were elected on November 2, 2004. The four Commissioners sworn in were Republican Don Wallace - District I, Republican Gary Youngblood - District II, Democrat Bobby Miller - District III, and Democrat Reginald Murray - District IV. Commissioner Miller is entering his eighth term, Commissioner Youngblood and Commissioner Murray are entering their third term, and Commissioner Wallace is entering his first term as a County Commissioner.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to install three (3) way stop signs at Old Cottondale Road and Pelham Heights Road, and to establish and post a 35 MPH speed limit on Old Cottondale Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a "Permit Agreement for the Accommodation of Utility Facilities on Public Right-of-Way" for Coaling Water Authority. This will permit Coaling Water Authority, Inc. to place a ten inch steel casing across Hargrove Road near Doyle Road to provide water to Country Highlands Subdivision.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a material option with Brown Wood Preserving Co. at forty cents per cubic yard for sand/clay.

On which land the definite location of the material to be removed has been designated to the undersigned; under the following conditions, to wit: Payment for the material removed from the above described land shall be at the rate of \$ .40 per cubic yard by loose volume in the same manner as payment to the County's hauling contractor(s) or agent(s) and that payment shall be made to the undersigned by the County or its contractor(s), within thirty (30) days after the expiration of each calendar month in which this material was removed, and it is hereby agreed that no payment shall be made to the undersigned for any stripping or material necessarily removed in securing suitable material. The County or its contractor(s) will remove without charge any or all such stripping or material to any spot on the land designated by the undersigned, within three hundred (300) feet of the place of excavation, and that the above payment will compensate the undersigned in full for any damages to the land incurred in the removal and disposal of these materials.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the STATE OF ALABAMA, acting by and through the ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, party of the first part (hereinafter called the State), and TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA (FEIN 63-6001719), party of the second part (hereinafter called the County):

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and County desire to cooperate in the construction of a 60'-115'-60' AASHTO girder bridge on CR59 @ Hurricane Creek. BIN 005367. Length - 0.044 miles. Project #ACGBBR-BR-6318(201), TCP 63-02-00. cpms ref #100044694.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the State and County as follows;

- A. The County will furnish all Right-of-Way for project without cost to the State or this Project.
- B. The County will adjust and/or relocate all Utilities on the project without cost to the State or this Project.
- C. The County will make the survey, complete the plans and furnish all preliminary engineering for the project with County forces without cost to the State or this Project or with a consultant selected by the State or with State forces as a part of the project cost. The plans will be subject to the approval of the State and the project will be constructed in accordance with the plans approved by the State and the terms of this Agreement.
- D. The County will furnish all construction engineering for the project with County forces or with a consultant selected by the State or with State forces as a part of the project cost.
- E. The County will file an Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Notice of Registration (NOR) (Code Chapter 335-6-12) for this project without cost to the State or this project. The County will be the permittee of record with ADEM for the permit. The contractor shall be a co-permittee with the County for the permit, and shall comply with all requirements of the permit. The County and the contractor will be responsible for compliance with the permit and the State will have no obligation regarding the permit. The County will furnish the State (Division) a copy of the permit prior to any work being performed by the contractor.
- F. The State will furnish the necessary inspection and testing of materials when needed as part of the cost of the project.
- G. Funding for this Agreement is subject to availability of Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds at the time of authorization. The State will not be liable for Federal Aid funds or State funds in any amount. Any deficiency in Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds, or overrun in constructions costs will be borne by the County from the County's allocation of Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds, if available, from County FA funds, if available, and/or from County funds.
- H. The estimated cost of construction of this project payable by the parties is the amount set forth below:

County FA Funds (2003)	\$126,712.00
County Funds	31,678.00
Federal GARVEE Bond Funds	\$579,843.00
General Obligation Bond Funds	<u>144,961.00</u>
Total (Incl. E & I)	\$883,194.00
- I. The State will be responsible for advertisement and receipt of bids, and the award of the Contract. Following the receipt of bids and prior to the award of the Contract, the State will invoice the County for its prorata share of the estimated cost as reflected by the bid of the successful bidder plus E & I, and the County will pay this amount to the State no later than 30 days after the date bids are opened.
- J. The County will submit reimbursement invoices for work performed under the terms of this Agreement to the Alabama Department of Transportation within six (6) months after the completion and acceptance of the project. Any invoices submitted after this six (6) month period will not be eligible for payment.
- K. The County will comply with the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2002 Edition, on this project and will ensure that alignment and grades on this project meet the standards of the Alabama Department of Transportation and the project will be built in accordance with the approved plans.

L. An audit report must be filed with the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, upon receipt by the County, for any audit performed on this project in accordance with Act No. 94-414.

M. Upon completion and acceptance of this project, the County will maintain the project in satisfactory condition in accordance with the requirements of the Alabama Department of Transportation.

O. Exhibit N is attached hereto as a part hereof.

P. This Agreement will terminate January 15, 2007, for project if project has not been authorized to be let to contract.


**ESTABLISHING REGULAR MEETING DAYS**


WHEREAS, the County Commission has previously established that regular meetings will be held on the first and third Wednesdays of each month; and

**RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED  
VACATION OF A PUBLIC STREET IN TUSCALOOSA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Fulmer Investments, LLC desires to vacate a public road or right-of-way within Tuscaloosa County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ala. Code §11-49-6 and §23-4-20 (1975), the County Commission of Tuscaloosa County is required to hold a public hearing, notice of which is required by statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA, as follows:

That a public hearing shall be held on Wednesday, November 10, 2004, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission Chambers of the Tuscaloosa County Courthouse, to address a proposed vacation of the former Coley Road, also known as Trixie Lane, a prescriptive public right-way in Tuscaloosa County, described as follows, to-wit:

A prescriptive right of way in, to, upon, and over all of that road sometimes known as the Coley Road and later named Trixie Lane located in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, in the NW1/4 of S8, T20S, R10W, said road having been publicly maintained at a certain time by the County Commission and now no longer in use as a public road.

See Exhibit "A" attached hereto depicting the proposed area of vacation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Ala. Code §11-49-6 and §23-4-20 (1975) that the petitioner, Fulmer Investments, LLC, shall publish this resolution in a newspaper of general circulation in the portion of the county where the street, alley, or highway lies once a week for four consecutive weeks, and provide proof of the same, in the county prior to deciding the issue at a regularly scheduled meeting of the governing body. A copy of the notice shall be posted on a bulletin board at the county courthouse and shall also be served by U.S. mail at least 30 days prior to the scheduled meeting on any abutting owner and on any entity known to have facilities or equipment such as utility lines, both aerial or buried, within the public right-of-way of the street, alley, or highway to be vacated.
