This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on reinforcing steel to O'Ferrell Rebar, Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened February 2, 2005.

Upon request by the County Engineer, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to extend Spraymax, Inc.'s herbicide application contract for one (1) additional year. The contract was originally awarded to Spraymax on March 6, 2002.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant Alabama Gas and Miller Pipeline a permit to make an open cut of the road at 21211 Lakeview Drive.

The following changes on the above numbered project, with stations, quantities and items involved, are recommended for the reasons stated below:

#### (1) Location, Description and Reason for Change

 From station 264+71 rt. to station 336+63 rt., chain link fence is needed for the Alabama Department of Mental Health property, which was agreed upon but not included in the contract.




