This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications on the following road projects:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to comply with requirements of the Federal Highway Administration to facilitate construction improvements on Keene's Mill Road, Green Acres Lane, and Green Acres Drive - Project Number DPI-0080(901), commonly referred to as the Eastern By-Pass.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 25 MPH speed limit on Butler Ridge Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the eight (8) vehicles listed on the attached exhibit as surplus. These vehicles will be sold at auction by Alabama Liquidation Corp.

Upon request from the State Department of Human Resources, and upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to repair Mr. Henry Banks' driveway at 11552 Mt. Moriah Road, Woodstock, Alabama. This improvement is being made to assure that health care personnel will be able to serve Mr. Banks.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to hire McGiffert and Associates, Inc. for the design and engineering for Carrolls Creek Parkway.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum informed the County Commission that the Alabama Department of Transportation, through the Fifth Division County Transportation Engineer, Mr. Robin Rhoden, has agreed to provide general oversight and approval of all plans and

other documents relating to Federal and State Aid projects that require the signature of a Professional Engineer. This assistance is being provided during the absence of Tuscaloosa County's Engineer, Bobby Hagler. Mr. Hagler has been activated by the U.S. Military for deployment to Iraq.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to act as applicant for the on-going LEGIONS grant through the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, Law Enforcement Planning. The Commission further agreed to be accountable for providing the 25 percent cash match.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and supporting the submission of an application for grant funds under the Juvenile Justice Title V Primary Prevention Grant Program through the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs. This is a continuation grant that provides funds to assist the implementation of a primary prevention program for juveniles in Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for Ambulance Service for the Tuscaloosa County Jail to NorthStar EMS as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened May 18, 2005.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare thirty-seven outdated processors surplus. This will facilitate disposal of said machines by auction. Processors not sold will go to the dump.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to renew

Waste Management of Alabama, Inc.'s solid waste collection and disposal service contract with Tuscaloosa County for an additional three (3) years, from July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2008.

Upon recommendation by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Willie and Donita Thomas \$1,000 for their portion of the rights-of-way required to replace the bridge six-tenths of a mile west of Hwy 11 on Dry Creek Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the contract offered by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers dated March 14, 2005. Under this continuation contract, the Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Office will provide law enforcement service for the Corps of Engineers on Oliver and Holt Lakes in Tuscaloosa County. Patrols will be concentrated at Oliver and Dam Fishing Pier, Rocky Branch Park, Burchfield Branch Park, and Deerlick Creek Park during periods of heavy use.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Dr. Robert Mellown and Mr. David Nash, and to appoint Dr. Linda Beito, to the Heritage Commission of Tuscaloosa County. The terms will expire as follows: Dr. Mellown, September 30, 2009; Mr. David Nash, September 30, 2009; and Dr. Linda Beito, September 30, 2008.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted three to one to adjourn the County Commission meeting and to go into executive session to discuss the applicants that have applied for the position of Tuscaloosa County License Commissioner. The current License Commissioner, Lee A. Hallman, is retiring effective July 1, 2005. Commissioner Bobby Miller cast the NAY vote.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, to hire University of Alabama Benefits Director Sandra Abrams as the next License Commissioner for Tuscaloosa County failed on a tie vote. Commissioner Gary Youngblood and Commissioner Bobby Miller cast the NAY votes.





Commissioner Gary Youngblood and Commissioner Bobby Miller cast the NAY votes.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's second motion to hire Tuscaloosa County Assistant Deputy License Commissioner Dorothy Collins as Tuscaloosa County's License Commissioner failed for lack of a second.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Friday, July 1, 2005.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Tuscaloosa (hereinafter at times referred to as the County) is desirous of having certain improvements made on Keene's Mill Road, Green Acres Lane and Green Acres Drive, in accordance with plans prepared by the Alabama Department of Transportation and designated as Project No. DPI-0080 (901).

WHEREAS, The Alabama Department of Transportation is now or may later be desirous of receiving Federal Aid for improvement of said highway; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Highway Administration, an agency of the United States of America will not participate in any funding for the construction of said project until and unless the County will agree to certain requirements of the Federal Highway Administration. The County for the purpose of complying with requirements of the Federal Highway Administration in regard to its funding of improvements of the type and kind in this agreement provided for does hereby pass and adopts the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of Tuscaloosa, that the plans of said project including alignment, profile, grades, typical sections and paving layouts as submitted to this County and which are now on file in the office of the County Clerk are hereby approved and that the location of said project as staked out by the Alabama Department of Transportation as shown by said plans referred to are hereby approved and the Alabama Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is hereby authorized to proceed with the grading, draining, paving, and otherwise improving and construction of said project in accordance with said plans.

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The County by and through its Commission hereby grants to the Alabama Department of Transportation the full use of and access to the dedicated widths of any existing streets for the construction of said project and hereby agrees to permit and allow the Alabama Department of Transportation to close and barricade the said project and intersecting streets for as long as necessary while the said project is being graded, drained, paved, and otherwise improved, and hereby agrees that the use of any street or highway for parking within an interchange area will not at any time be permitted and hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify ALDOT, its officer and employees in both their official and individual capacities and agrees to hold harmless and indemnify ALDOT and its employees from any claim of cause of action whatsoever brought as a result of said closures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Commission that for and in consideration of the Alabama Department of Transportation in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, constructing said highway and routing traffic along the same through the County over said project, such County hereby agrees with the Alabama Department of Transportation and for benefit of the Federal Highway Administration, that on the above mentioned project the County will not in the future permit encroachments upon the right of way; nor will it pass any ordinances or laws fixing a speed limit contrary to those limits provided for in Title 32, Chapter 5, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, and other laws of Alabama; nor will it permit other parallel parking in areas where parking is permitted; nor will it allow the placing of any informational, regulatory, or warning signs, signals, median crossover, curb and pavement or other markings, and traffic signals without written approval of the Alabama Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, of the location, form and character of such installations. The traffic control devices and signs installed during construction, and those installed after completion of his project shall be in accordance with the latest edition of the national Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and accepted standards adopted by the Alabama Department of Transportation and by the Federal Highway Administration. The County further agrees that subsequent traffic control devices deemed necessary by it in keeping with applicable statutes, rules and regulations to promote the safe and efficient utilization of the highway under the authority of Title 32, Chapter 5, Code of Alabama 1975, and all other applicable laws of Alabama, shall be subject to and must have the Federal Highway Administration, prior to installation and the County further agrees that it will enforce traffic and control the same under the provisions of Title 32, Chapter 5, Code of Alabama 1975, and other applicable laws of Alabama.

It is understood and agreed that no changes in this Resolution Agreement shall in the future be made without having obtained the prior approval of the Federal Highway Administration.
