TUSCALOOSA COUNTY §  
STATE OF ALABAMA §

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Gary Youngblood

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the City of Northport's request and permit Northport to annex Rose Boulevard and a portion of Union Chapel Road into the City of Northport as shown in the attached exhibit. Presently, portions of the roads are in the city limits of Northport and the unincorporated areas of the county.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a material option with Mitch Freeman at forty-five cents a cubic yard for earth.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of an agreement with the City of Tuscaloosa granting

the city permission to open cut Bobby Miller Parkway in order to provide water service for the proposed Fields Crossing Subdivision.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the county's 1977 Pettibone 18-ton crane, VIN number 6431, as surplus. This crane will be auctioned off at the Alabama Liquidation Sale Yard.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the following base process projects to the low bidder meeting specifications. There were only two bidders: Mallory Burkhalter Paving, Inc. and S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented a twenty-five year service pin to Deputy Newton Malone and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Upon request by Concerned Citizens of Holt, and upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to be a sponsor and to waive the tipping fees on debris collected during the "Renew Our Rivers" Holt Lake clean-up. This clean-up program will remove plastic and other litter from the river.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the months of June and July, 2005.

Exhibit 8-8, Pages 803-804

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to transfer \$1,000,000 from the Capital Projects Fund and up to \$1,500,000 from the General Fund to the Road and Bridge Fund. These transfers are necessary because the State of Alabama has reimbursed only \$900,000 of some 7.4 million dollars in reimbursements due Tuscaloosa County. This will facilitate continued operations of the Road and Bridge Department.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a revised "Road Usage Agreement" for methane operations in Tuscaloosa County. Under this agreement, methane operators agree to return the roadways to the same condition as they were in immediately prior to the company's beginning operations which required their use of said roads. Tuscaloosa County will bid out the work necessary to restore and repair the roadways. The company agrees that it will reimburse the county for all monies expended by the county relating to the bidding out and performance of the work to repair affected roadways.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a revised "Road Usage Agreement" to be entered into with companies using heavy equipment on county roadways. Under this agreement, the company agrees to return the roadways to the same condition as they were in immediately prior to the company's beginning operations which required their use of said roads. Tuscaloosa

County will bid out the work necessary to restore and repair the roadways. The company agrees that it will reimburse the county for all monies expended by the county relating to the bidding out and performance of the work to repair affected roadways. This agreement relates to subdivisions.

Exhibit 8-10, Pages 807-808

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a Service Agreement between the City of Tuscaloosa, the City of Northport, Tuscaloosa County, and Tuscaloosa Metro Animal Shelter, Inc. This agreement, which will be effective September 27, 2005, is for three years unless otherwise terminated. The \$316,500 per year contract will be paid as follows: the City of Tuscaloosa will pay 42.5 percent, Tuscaloosa County will pay 44.4 percent, and Northport will pay 13.1 percent in monthly installments.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the sixteen Sheriff's Office vehicles listed on the attached exhibit as surplus. These vehicles will be sold at the next auction by Alabama Liquidation Sale Yard on Highway 69 South.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the \$6,014,955.21 package of bids for construction of the proposed Community Activity Center at Newt Hinton Park on Bobby Miller Parkway with the understanding that an effort will be made to trim (reduce) \$260,000 from the bids. This will bring construction cost within budget. Commissioner Miller agreed to cover any portion of the \$260,000 reduction not realized by negotiations from his budget.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Dave Rodgers to the Tuscaloosa Public Library Board of Directors. This term began August 1, 2004, and will expire August 1, 2008.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Ms. Shirley Peeples and Mr. Ron Turner to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation Board of Bibb, Pickens, and Tuscaloosa Counties, Inc. These new terms began April 1, 2004, and April 1, 2005, and will expire April 1, 2010, and April 1, 2011, respectively.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Mr. Farrell Noland to the Buhl, Elrod and Holman Water Authority. This new term began March 1, 2005, and will expire March 1, 2011.


Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Mr. John Foster, Jr. to the Coaling Water and Fire Authority, Inc. This new term began March 1, 2005, and will expire March 1, 2011.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Mr. Bill Lamb and Mr. Craig Williams to the Tuscaloosa Metro Animal Shelter Advisory Committee. This term began August 1, 2005, and will expire August 1, 2009.


Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to add Panther Drive and Cougar Drive (approximately 550 feet total) in Brookwood on the county's two dollar a foot citizen participation program. The citizens pay two dollars per foot and Tuscaloosa County paves the road.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to endorse the proposed widening of 6,400 linear feet of U.S. Highway Number 11 from B.F. Goodrich Boulevard to Black Warrior Parkway. This project will turn the two-lane section into a three-lane section. There will be a dedicated turn lane in the middle of the road with side curbs and gutter and a full length sidewalk on one side of the roadway.

Gentlemen:

The current three year shelter contract ends September 27, 2005. We have gone through the bid process. Judy Hill/Metro Animal Shelter, Inc. in 2002 was the only bidder. Copies of those documents are enclosed for each of you. The City of Tuscaloosa will probably approve and accept this bid in the next week or two, as will Northport I suspect.

Here are the numbers. The current three year contract total cost is \$275,500.00 per year. The new bid is \$316,500.00 per year, a \$41,000.00 per year increase, a 15% increase.

The percentages paid by each government are changing slightly: the City of Tuscaloosa from 45% to 42.5%, Tuscaloosa County from 41% to 44.4%, and Northport from 14% to 13.1%.

The cost to Tuscaloosa County goes from \$9,412.92 per month to \$11,710.50 per month, \$2,297.58 more per month. On a yearly basis, Tuscaloosa County goes from \$112,955.04 per year to \$140,526.00 per year, an increase of \$27,570.96.

It is my recommendation that Tuscaloosa County accept the bid and enter into a new contract based on these terms. Judy Hill has been and still is the only entity interested in running the shelter at all. Nobody else bid back in 2002, and again no one else has submitted a bid but her this time. The increase is 5% per year from the old contract, which is not unreasonable in light of the extra expenses, overhead and costs. She has run the operation smoothly for a number of years. Also, the number of animals received has increased by roughly 1,000 over the last three years, up to over 8,000 animals received currently each year. The grant announced in April of this year from the Duffield Family Foundation/Maddie's Fund should increase the number of adoptions. The shelter has already seen some of that increase occur since the grant was announced.
