This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the recommendations of the County Engineer to award and reject some of the annual bids opened September 21, 2005, as follows:

The county received only one (1) bid for mosquito control chemicals, treated bridge timbers, silt fence materials, and silt fence installed. The county rejected all four because the bid quotes were too high.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider two items - utility permits for (one) Warrior River Water Authority and (two) City of Tuscaloosa that were not on today's agenda.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant Warrior River Water Authority a utility permit to open cut Belcher Drive at the intersection of Oak Forest Drive to tap into the water main. Warrior River Water Authority is laying 1160 feet of 6 inch ductile iron pipe along Oak Forest Drive, off road in the county's right-of-way.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant the City of Tuscaloosa a right-of-way permit to lay a sanitary sewer force main (265 L.F.) along Patriot Parkway from the east end of exiting Patriot Parkway to the intersection of Revere Road. The city will make a tie-in on Revere Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for assembly hardware to the low bidder meeting specifications. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with Sheriff Ted Sexton's decision to award the bid for one or more digital color copiers to Warrior Business Machines. The bid was opened September 21, 2005.


Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve Addendum No. 4 to the Management Agreement for the Tuscaloosa County Juvenile Detention Center. The addendum extends the management agreement for a period beginning October 1, 2005, until the completion of the new facility now under construction, but does not extend beyond September 30, 2006.


Upon presentation by County Attorney Robert Spence, the County Commission approved the renewal of the county's Court Referral Officer contract with the Administrative Director of Courts, Judicial Branch, State of Alabama. This contractual agreement will be in effect for the period October 1, 2005, through September 30, 2006, unless terminated in accordance with the terms of this contract.


Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Dr. Barbara Spencer to the Tuscaloosa County Department of Human Resources Board of Directors. This term expires September 1, 2011.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented Tuscaloosa County's General Fund and Road & Bridge Budgets for fiscal 2005-2006. This will give all commission members a minimum of two weeks to review the proposed budgets.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 19, 2005.

PERMIT AGREEMENT FOR THE ACCOMMODATION OF UTILITY FACILITIES ON PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

THIS AGREEMENT made the 4 day of October 2005 between the COUNTY OF TUSCALOOSA, the STATE OF ALABAMA,

and Warrior River Water Authority P.O. Box 326 McCalla, Al. 35111 doing business at 22805 Bucksville Rd 205 477 5791 hereinafter referred to as Grantee".

1. RIGHT OF WAY: In consideration of the sum of \$2.00 per linear foot, Grantor hereby grants, permits and conveys to Grantee a permit for the purposes of laying, constructing, operating, inspecting, maintaining, repairing, replacing, substituting, relocating, and removing 1160 feet of 6" ductile iron pipe along Oak Forest Drive. WRWA will have to open cut Belcher Drive, with intent to pave immediately upon coverage line extension.

at a location and on a route to be selected by the Grantor, on, in, over and through the following described land in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama; generally along County roads as follows:

Only open cut: ON Belcher Drive for tapping of water main. All line extension on Oak Forest will be off road in right of way.

, all being in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, more particularly described on the attached map, which said map is on file in the County Engineer's Office, said route to be determined finally by the Grantor herein. At such time as Grantee has decided the final route of said utility, the County Engineer will calculate the total footage of same, and Grantee will pay the cost of same based on such calculation before construction begins thereon. Such road rights-of ways are sometimes referred to herein as the premises.

2. TERM: The rights granted herein shall be possessed and enjoyed by Grantee so long as the utilities and appurtenances constructed pursuant hereto shall be maintained and operated by Grantee

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN TUSCALOOSA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA FOR A COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT**

**THIS AGREEMENT** made the \_\_\_\_ day of May, 2005, between the COUNTY OF TUSCALOOSA, STATE OF ALABAMA, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor," and the CITY OF TUSCALOOSA, a Municipal Corporation, doing business at 2201 University Boulevard, Tuscaloosa, Alabama 35401, and Old Marion Development, LLC hereinafter referred to as "Grantees."

1. **RIGHT OF WAY.** In consideration of the benefits deriving each to the other, Grantor hereby grants, permits and conveys to Grantees a permit for the purposes of laying, constructing, operating, inspecting, maintaining, repairing, replacing, substituting, relocating or removing the following:

A SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN (265 L.F.) ALONG PATRIOT PARKWAY FROM THE EAST END OF EXITING PATRIOT PARKWAY TO THE INTERSECTION TO THE INTERSECTION OF REVERE ROAD; THE PROJECT (BRAELIN VILLAGE) CONSISTS OF A TOTAL OF 129 LOTS IN 4 PHASES AND IS LOCATED IN SW/4 OF SE/4 OF SECTION 13, T22S, R10W IN TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA. A WATER MAIN WILL ALSO CONNECT AT THE EAST END OF PATRIOT PARKWAY.

All being in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, more particularly described on the attached map, which said map is on file in the County Engineer's Office, said route to be determined finally by the Grantee herein. Such road rights-of-way are sometimes referred to herein as "the premises."

2. **TERM.** The rights granted herein shall be possessed and enjoyed by Grantee so long as the pipelines and appurtenances constructed pursuant hereto shall be maintained and operated by Grantees.

3. **ADDITIONAL RIGHTS OF GRANTEES.** Grantees shall have the right of ingress and egress to and from the premises for any and all purposes necessary or convenient to the exercise by Grantees of the rights granted herein, such right not to unreasonably interfere with the normal traffic of the County roads described as the premises and with reasonable advance notice to Grantor of all work to be done thereon.

4. **RIGHTS OF GRANTOR.** Grantor reserves the right to use and enjoy the premises to the fullest possible extent without unreasonable interference with the exercise by Grantees of the rights granted herein. It is understood by and between the Grantor and the Grantees that this is a non-exclusive permit, and Grantor reserves the right to convey similar or other permits to public utilities or private parties.
