This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

County Engineer Bobby Hagler reported that the current cost to the county (materials and labor) to chip seal a road is \$6.00 per linear foot.

The one bid received on December 21, 2005, from Mallory Burkhalter Paving, Inc. for the construction of a speed table on Crabtree Road was tabled. The County Commission asked the County Engineer to determine if county crews could construct speed tables for less than the bid price of \$6,700.00.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant the City of Tuscaloosa utility permits to open-cut the following roads:


1. 59th Avenue East: 300 feet north of intersection of 59th Avenue East and Alabama Highway 215 for installation of sanitary sewer system


2. Buttermilk Road: 30 feet west of intersection of Buttermilk Road and 59th Avenue East for installation of sanitary sewer system
3. In front of 3825 - 16th Street N.E. in Holt to install water service



Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Attorney to file an injunction against Mr. Willie Tinker to stop the development of an illegal subdivision adjacent to Wesley Chapel Road. Mr. Tinker lives at 14746 Woods Creek Lane.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, January 18, 2006.
