This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to install 3-WAY STOP signs at both intersections of Crabtree Road and Crabtree Circle.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to install a 3-WAY STOP sign at the intersection of Shamblin Road and Shamblin Cut-off Road and to post "NO TRUCKS" on Shamblin Cut-off Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the installation of an additional speed table on Crabtree Road and two speed tables on Plantation Road.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to enter into an agreement with the State of Alabama to cooperate in the construction of a CT 12x5 RC bridge

culvert on Dry Creek Road at Dry Creek - Project No. ACGBBRZ-6300(215), TCP 63-14-01.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Attorney to proceed with the required process (advertising, etc.) to vacate a portion of Greenville Drive.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to sell a 1994 Crown Vic, serial number 2FALP71W5RX146676, to Samantha Volunteer Fire Department for \$1,000.00.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Buhl, Elrod & Holman Water Authority \$2,425.28 for relocating a water line on Jackson Johnson Road due to a county road construction project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Englewood Hulls Water System \$35,379.46 for relocating a water line on H.B. Johnson Road due to a county road construction project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Mitchell Water System \$35,894.35 for relocating a water line on Old Marion Road due to the construction of a new bridge.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Fosters Ralph Water Authority \$6,440.30 for relocating a water line on Water Tower Road due to a county road project.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Fosters Ralph Water Authority \$31,540.28 for relocating a water line on Dry Creek Road due to the construction of a new bridge.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a road maintenance agreement with the Town of Woodstock contingent upon the Town of Woodstock's approval of said agreement.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider vacating the old alignment (right of way) and a bridge on Hannah Creek Road.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to vacate the old prescriptive alignment (right of way) for the bridge across Davis Creek on Hannah Creek Road. Jim Walter Resources deeded new alignment (right of way) to Tuscaloosa County and a new bridge was constructed across Davis Creek on the new alignment. The old alignment and bridge will belong to Jim Walter Resources.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to review the one bid received for ten (10) 6'-10'-6' speed tables and to accept the bid if it meets specifications. The bidding firm was as follows:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for December, 2005.

Exhibit 2-7, Page 234

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to honor a request from Citizens Water System to provide fifty percent match (\$133,247.50) of the funds required to extend water service to Pheasant Drive, Whipporwill Drive, and Deer Chase Road. The Commission concurred with Citizen Water System's decision to contract with Hill Engineering Group LLC from Trussville to serve as project engineer at a cost of \$34,760.00.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted four to one to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider changing the county's fifty percent match policy on County Commission district water extension projects to a twenty-five percent match under certain circumstances. The motion failed because under the Commission's "RULES OF PROCEDURE" a unanimous vote is required to depart from the official agenda. Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum cast the NAY vote, stating that the Commission should be consistent and not change a written policy that will wrong water authorities/systems that have previously participated in the program under the fifty-fifty match policy.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted three to one to approve a second round of Commissioners district water projects

as listed on the attached exhibit, with the exception of Lagrone Road and Myers Road water projects, which were deleted due to right-of-way problems and problems with moving a gas line. The motion also stated that Tuscaloosa County's Alabama Capital Improvement Fund would be used to pay for Tuscaloosa County's fifty percent match on these projects. The motion also allowed each commissioner to provide an additional twenty-five percent of the water authorities/systems fifty percent match from his General Fund District Development monies. Commissioner Bobby Miller cast the NAY vote, stating that he is of the opinion that this is unfair to the water authorities/systems that have previously contributed fifty percent match on water projects.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a Revised Reorganization Plan for the Tax Assessor's Appraisal and Mapping Department. This reorganization was caused by an employee declining to accept a position they had previously indicated they would accept. The pre-reorganization positions and budget, post-reorganization and budget, and the proposed revised reorganization and budget are shown on the attached exhibit.


Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the Sheriff's Office's decision to hire someone on a part-time basis to assist with animal control in rural Tuscaloosa County. According to Chief Deputy Ron Abernathy, there are sufficient funds in the Sheriff's Office budget to fund this position.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to contract with the Town of Coaling agreeing to provide a deputy to patrol in the town, pending approval of the contract. This approximately \$70,000 contract, which includes salary, vehicle and benefits, is being written by County Attorney Robert Spence. The deputy will be stationed in Coaling.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish Tuscaloosa County's alcoholic beverage license fees for fiscal 2006-2007. The levies remain the same as last year.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, February 15, 2006.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the STATE OF ALABAMA, acting by and through the ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, party of the first part (hereinafter called the State), and TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA (FEIN 63-6001719), party of the second part (hereinafter called the County):

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and County desire to cooperate in the construction of a CT 12x5 RC bridge culvert on Dry Creek Road @ Dry Creek. BIN 017614. Length - 0.012 miles. Proj.#ACGBBRZ-6300(215), TCP 63-14-01. CPMS REF #100047817.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the State and County as follows;

A. The County will furnish all Right-of-Way for project without cost to the State or this Project.

B. The County will adjust and/or relocate all Utilities on the project without cost to the State or this Project.

C. The County will make the survey, complete the plans and furnish all preliminary engineering for the project with County forces without cost to the State or this Project or with a consultant selected by the State or with State forces as a part of the project cost. The plans will be subject to the approval of the State and the project will be constructed in accordance with the plans approved by the State and the terms of this Agreement.

D. The County will furnish all construction engineering for the project with County forces or with a consultant selected by the State or with State forces as a part of the project cost.

E. The County will file an Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Notice of Registration (NOR) (Code Chapter 335-6-12) for this project without cost to the State or this project. The County will be the permittee of record with ADEM for the permit. The contractor shall be a co-permittee with the County for the permit, and shall comply with all requirements of the permit. The County and the contractor will be responsible for compliance with the permit and the State will have no obligation regarding the permit. The County will furnish the State (Division) a copy of the permit prior to any work being performed by the contractor.

F. The State will furnish the necessary inspection and testing of materials when needed as part of the cost of the project.

G. Funding for this Agreement is subject to availability of Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds at the time of authorization. The State will not be liable for Federal Aid funds or State funds in any amount. Any deficiency in Federal Garvee Bond Funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond Funds, or overrun in constructions costs will be borne by the County from the County's allocation of Federal Garvee Bond Funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond Funds, if available, from County FA Funds, if available, and/or from County Funds.

H. The estimated cost of construction of this project payable by the parties is the amount set forth below:

Federal GARVEE Bond Funds	\$ 122,416.00
General Obligation Bond Funds	30,604.00
Total (Incl. E & I)	\$ 153,020.00

I. The State will be responsible for advertisement and receipt of bids, and the award of the Contract. Following the receipt of bids and prior to the award of the Contract, the State will invoice the County for its prorata share of the estimated cost as reflected by the bid of the successful bidder plus E & I, and the County will pay this amount to the State no later than 30 days after the date bids are opened.

J. The County will submit reimbursement invoices for work performed under the terms of this Agreement to the Alabama Department of Transportation within six (6) months after the completion and acceptance of the project. Any invoices submitted after this six (6) month period will not be eligible for payment.

K. The County will comply with the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2002 Edition, on this project and will ensure that alignment and grades on this project meet the standards of the Alabama Department of Transportation and the project will be built in accordance with the approved plans.

L. An audit report must be filed with the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, upon receipt by the County, for any audit performed on this project in accordance with Act No. 94-414.

M. Upon completion and acceptance of this project, the County will maintain the project in satisfactory condition in accordance with the requirements of the Alabama Department of Transportation.

N. Exhibit M is attached hereto as a part hereof.

O. Exhibit N is attached hereto as a part hereof.

P. This Agreement will terminate January 15, 2007, for project if project has not been authorized to be let to contract.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this agreement to be executed by those officers, officials and persons thereunto duly authorized, and the agreement is deemed to be dated and to be effective on the date stated hereinafter as the date of the approval of the Governor of Alabama.

Any person who fails to file the required certification shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$10,000 and not more than \$100,000 for each such failure.

The prospective participant/recipient also agrees by submitting this Federal contract, grant, loan, cooperative agreement or other instrument as might be applicable under Section 1352, Title 31, U. S. It is further agreed that if any provision of this Agreement shall contravene any statute or Constitutional provision of amendment, either now in effect or which may, during the course of this Agreement, be enacted, then the conflicting provision in the Agreement shall be deemed null and void.

TERMINATION DUE TO INSUFFICIENT FUNDS:

If the Agreement term is to exceed more than one fiscal year, then said Agreement is subject to termination in the event that funds should not be appropriated for the continued payment of the Agreement in subsequent fiscal years.

In the event of proration of the fund from which payment under this Agreement is to be made, Agreement will be subject to termination.

ADR CLAUSE:

For any and all disputes arising under the terms of this contract, the parties hereto agree, in compliance with the recommendation of the Governor and Attorney General, when considering settlement of such disputes, to utilize appropriate forms of non-binding alternative dispute resolution including, but not limited to, mediation by and through the Attorney General Office of Administrative Hearings or where appropriate, private mediators.
