This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Reginald Murray

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on the construction of Chism Road, Boxwood Drive, and Junkins Drive to Vinson Trucking and Contracting as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened May 3, 2006.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for construction of Albert Sanders Road, Sanford Lane, and Walton Drive to Vinson Trucking and Contracting as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened May 3, 2006.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for base processing on Water Tower Road to S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened May 3, 2006.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for construction of Old Cheatum Road. Bidders were as follows:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the bid from S.T. Bunn Construction Co., Inc. on the planing and resurfacing of Patriot Parkway, if the bid meets specifications.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Buhl, Elrod, and Holman Water Authority \$8,790.42 for relocating a water line on Frank Redd Road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Coker Water Authority \$16,151.39 for relocating water lines on Tallahassee Road, Sunnybrook Road, and Bailey Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to post Moore Road "NO TRUCKS".

Upon notification from Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc., and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay the engineering firm of McGuire and Associates, Inc. \$3,494 for office and field work for topographic survey in May, 2002, coordination of field work in July, 2002, and a look at earthwork quantities in January, 2003. These three invoices were for work done on the Bull Slough Road Bridge Replacement Project in 2002.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to provide \$20,000 to the City of Northport to assist with the dredging of Northwood Lake, providing Northport monitors the project. The Northwood Lake Homeowners Association has secured a \$100,000 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Grant, a \$30,000 commitment from the City of Northport, and collected \$35,000 from the residents of Northwood Lake Subdivision to pay for dredging the sixty-five acre lake. The lake has become unsuitable for fishing, swimming, etc. because of siltation accumulation from contiguous construction in the area.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for one or more Hospital Decontamination Kits for the Sheriff's Office. Bidding firms were as follows:



Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to execute a Right of Entry form with Jack Johnson for his property at 11580 Church of God Loop, Coker, Alabama, and Mr. Johnson's appropriate adjoining landowner, in an effort to repair and eliminate further erosion of the two properties. The Church of God Loop road was raised approximately eighteen inches when Tuscaloosa County improved said road, increasing water flow


and erosion on the properties. The Commission further authorized the County Engineer to design a flume or ditch to accommodate the property owners and eliminate the erosion.


Upon inquiry from Mr. James Wood Wilson, Commissioner Don Wallace stated that the North Fork Farm Road that intersects Bull Slough Road will continue to be maintained by Tuscaloosa County down to the entrance of the Tuscaloosa Sailing Club's property on the banks of Lake Tuscaloosa, which has PRIVATE ROAD and NO PUBLIC ACCESS signs at the entrance of their property. Mr. Wilson had requested that all of North Fork Farm Road be vacated.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 7, 2006.
