MEETING

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Don Wallace
Gary Youngblood
Bobby Miller
Reginald Murray

Upon recommendation by County Engineer Bobby Hagler, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to reject the one bid received from Vinson Trucking & Contracting on the construction/earthwork on Powell Loop Road because of the excessive cost. The \$38,027.50 bid computes to a cost of \$237,671.88 per mile; similar projects cost \$143,281.97 per mile, according to the County Engineer.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bids opened June 21, 2006, to the low bidder meeting specifications as follows:

CONSTRUCTION OF FRANK REDD ROAD - Vinson Trucking & Contracting
BASING AND PAVING MYERS ROAD - Mallory Burkhalter Paving Inc.
REINFORCING STEEL - Gerdau Ameristeel

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize

the execution of a contract with Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. to redesign the replacement bridge over Cooley Creek on Eastern Valley Road. According to the County Engineer, the first design was made by Burk-Kleinpeter Inc. based on the recommendation of a consultant hired by the state. Now the state will not accept that design. The lump sum cost for this redesign is \$42,980.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to contract with Southeast Auction, Inc. to dispose of two (2) 1999 surplus Drott Badgers. One is unit 173, serial number 99024, and the second is unit 275, serial number 990106. The equipment was consigned to "Iron Planet" for disposal on April 19, 2006, but the county was not satisfied with Iron Planet's terms. Southeast Auction charges a five percent commission on gross sales.

Upon request by Coker Water Authority, and upon motion by Commissioner Don Wallace, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to allow the Authority to leave some thirty feet of water line under the pavement along Valleywood Road at the intersection of Upper Columbus Road and Valleywood Road. This action will allow the completion of a construction project on said road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to install 3-WAY STOP signs at the intersection of Lakewood Loop and Middle Lake Road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to waive the county's sixty foot right-of-way requirement to facilitate improving Koffman Ranch Road and Koffman Loop utilizing a forty foot right-of-way. This project will require laying approximately three hundred feet of forty-eight inch pipe along Koffman Ranch Road and Koffman Loop to facilitate improvements within a forty foot right-of-way.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to purchase lime-colored T-shirts for Tuscaloosa County employees in the Road and Bridge construction unit and all road flagmen.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the following projects to the low bidder meeting specifications:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to commit \$250,000 annually for four (4) years to the HOPE VI Rosedale Court Project. This \$20,000,000 project will demolish and replace the housing units in the Rosedale Court Complex on 10th Avenue.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize McGiffert and Associates Inc. to prepare an engineering contract for the design of the Progress Drive Phase II Road Project in Cedar Cove Technology Park in the Coaling area.

The Sheriff's Office notified the County Commission that the following firms were the low bidders meeting specifications on bids opened June 7, 2006:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to pass a

resolution adopting the National Incident Management System as the standard for incident management in Tuscaloosa County. This is to facilitate efficient and effective incident management for all governmental units during emergencies or disasters.




Commissioner Don Wallace's motion to add two (2) days of leave time across the board for all county employees beginning October 1, 2006, failed for lack of a second.


Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to adopt a resolution that would place the Self-Governance Act on the November, 2006, general election ballot failed for lack of a second. If this law is ever adopted by the voters of Tuscaloosa County, it will give the County Commission authority to control nuisances such as noise, litter, overgrown weeds, junk-yards, and animals beyond the jurisdiction of municipalities.



The vote must be unanimous to consider items not listed on the official agenda. Commissioner Reginald Murray cast the NAY vote.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the President in Homeland Security Directive (HSPD)-5, directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System (NIMS), which would provide a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State, local, and tribal governments to work together more effectively and efficiently to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size or complexity;

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Alabama in Executive Order Number 24 has established the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the State standard for incident management and directed the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and Alabama Department of Homeland Security to begin immediately to implement NIMS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that all Federal, State, local and tribal emergency agencies and personnel coordinate their efforts to effectively and efficiently provide the highest levels of incident management;

WHEREAS, to facilitate the most efficient and effective incident management it is critical that Federal, State, local, and tribal organizations utilize standardized terminology, standardized organizational structures, interoperable communications, consolidated action plans, unified command structures, uniform personnel qualification standards, uniform standards for planning, training, and exercising, comprehensive resource management, and designated incident facilities during emergencies or disasters;

WHEREAS, the NIMS standardized procedures for managing personnel, communications, facilities and resources will improve the County's ability to utilize federal funding to enhance local agency readiness, maintain first responder safety, and streamline incident management processes.

WHEREAS, the Incident Command System components of NIMS are already an integral part of various incident management activities throughout the County, including current emergency management training programs; and


WHEREAS, the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks (9-11 Commission) recommended adoption of a standardized Incident Command System;




