This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bids opened July 19, 2006, as follows:

CONSTRUCTION OF SULLIVAN ROAD to Vinson Trucking & Contracting  
CONSTRUCTION OF OREGONIA ROAD to Tomlin Construction LLC  
BASE PROCESSING ALBERT SANDERS ROAD to S.T. Bunn Construction  
BASE PROCESSING CHISM ROAD to S.T. Bunn Construction

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to renew a material option with Carl Walker for gravel at \$2.50 per cubic yard.

Commisisoner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into an agreement with the City of Tuscaloosa agreeing to cooperate on replacing the bridge on Bear Creek Cut-off Road. The proposal is for the city to furnish the material and Tuscaloosa County will install a new bridge.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to hire an architect to approve the drawings of the proposed addition to the Public Works building located at 2810 35th Street; and authorized bids to be sought on the proposed addition. Tuscaloosa County will compare the lowest bid price to a proposal from the Alabama Prison Industries to construct the addition using prison labor.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to install STOP signs at the following intersections:

- 4-WAY STOP at Meadowood Drive and Maxwell Loop Road N.
- 3-WAY STOP at Empress Boulevard and Maxwell Loop Road N.
- 3-WAY STOP at Sunnyland Drive and Maxwell Loop Road N.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the bid from Thompson Tractor Company Inc. on an undercarriage for a Caterpillar D6R Dozer Serial #2YN550, if it meets specifications.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented Major Mark Smith of the Salvation Army the first public service award ever given by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency director for leadership of Tuscaloosa County Volunteers during the aftermath of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. The plaque read "Public Service Award presented to Major Mark Smith in recognition of your outstanding leadership of Tuscaloosa County Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster". Tuscaloosa County volunteers assisted the many citizens displaced from the gulf coast to Tuscaloosa by the hurricanes.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to be a sponsor and assist with the dumping fees on debris collected during the second annual "RENEW OUR RIVERS" Holt Lake Clean-up. This clean-up is to remove cans, bottles, plastic, etc. from the waters of Holt Lake.

Planning Director Farrington Snipes presented to the County Commission the tabulations of bids opened July 25, 2006, on the Deer Chase Road, Whippoorwill Drive, and Pheasant Driver Water Main Extension.

Upon request by Tuscaloosa County License Commissioner Jeff Brown, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the creation of two full-time civil service entry level License Clerk positions in the License Office. These positions will be funded with funds previously used to fund temporary positions.

Bids for a telecommunications system and equipment for a mobile command post were opened and referred to the Sheriff's Office for appropriate action. Bidding firms were as follows:



Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department to proceed with the survey and to develop plans on the extension of Patriot Parkway to U.S. Highway 82.



Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to recognize Ms. Linda Sewell, who is retiring from Mercedes-Benz U.S. International automobile manufacturing plant by presenting her a certificate of appreciation. Ms. Sewell was very instrumental in convincing Mercedes-Benz to locate their plant in Tuscaloosa County.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 16, 2006.







Know all men by these presents that and in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid to the undersigned, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned Owner(s) or authorized representative(s) of mineral and surface rights of a certain tract of land hereinafter described, do(es) hereby grant unto TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, acting through the Tuscaloosa County Public Works Department, or its contractor, the right to remove such quantities of the above indicated material as desired for use in the land, hereinafter described, together with the use of whatever lands are necessary for a convenient temporary right of way between this tract of land and the Project for the duration of this instrument: said tract being approximately described as follows: \_\_\_\_\_

Section 17 - T5 24 N -RNG 4E

On which land the definite location of the material to be removed has been designated to the undersigned; under the following conditions, to wit: Payment for the material removed from the above described land shall be at the rate of \$ 2.50 per cubic yard by loose volume in the same manner as payment to the County's hauling contractor(s) or agent(s) and that payment shall be made to the undersigned by the County or its contractor(s), within thirty (30) days after the expiration of each calendar month in which this material was removed, and it is hereby agreed that no payment shall be made to the undersigned for any stripping or material necessarily removed in securing suitable material. The County or its contractor(s) will remove without charge any or all such stripping or material to any spot on the land designated by the undersigned, within three hundred (300) feet of the place of excavation, and that the above payment will compensate the undersigned in full for any damages to the land incurred in the removal and disposal of these materials.

This option to purchase the right to remove materials in accordance with the terms of this instrument shall be binding upon the undersigned, the undersigned heirs, assigns, or administrators from the date of its execution for a period of 1 Year

The undersigned authorized representative(s) hereby further state(s) that they have the right to give this option and to sell the said material and that the said land (pit) is free and clear of all liens, mortgages, encumbrances and/or reservations.

The undersigned owner(s) or authorized representative(s) agree(s) to obtain all applicable permits from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, and to maintain the property in conformance with all applicable rules and regulations. Copies of the permits will be provided to the Tuscaloosa County Engineer prior to the removal of any material from this property.

**OR**

This agreement for removal of material is exclusive to Tuscaloosa County. The undersigned owner(s) or authorized representative(s) agree(s) to take all reasonable steps necessary to ensure that no party other than Tuscaloosa County shall have access to material from the property. In exchange for this exclusive agreement, Tuscaloosa County agrees to undertake to acquire and maintain, during the term of this agreement, all necessary permits from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management.
