TUSCALOOSA COUNTY §
STATE OF ALABAMA §

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Gary Youngblood
Bobby Miller
Reginald Murray

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum recognized Deputy Tax Collector Jennifer Kuykendall for her thirty-five years of service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County and presented her a Tuscaloosa County service pin to mark the occasion.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award construction of Field Road and Arthur Creek Lane to Vinson Trucking and Contracting Co. The County Engineer negotiated the Field Road bid price of \$92,299.19 down to \$90,699.19 and the Arthur Creek Lane bid price of \$71,533.49 down to \$70,333.49. The bids were opened October 4, 2006.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for base processing on Frank Redd Road, Oregonia Road, and Sullivan Road to S.T. Bunn as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened October 4, 2006.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider posting a 45 MPH speed limit on Paul Howell Road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 45 MPH speed limit on Paul Howell Road.

There being no opposition from the public, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution assenting to the vacation of a portion of the Old Columbus Highway as described in the attached resolution. Said vacation was advertised as required by Alabama Law.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to deed a parcel of land located on Hargrove Road to the Alabama Public Health Care Authority. A new health building and health facility to meet present and future clinical and administrative health needs of the citizens of Tuscaloosa County will be constructed on this donated property.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept for maintenance by Tuscaloosa County a new road being opened into the old Prewitt Slave Cemetery, provided the County Attorney determines that it is legal to do so. The burial ground located off Old Byler Road near the northwestern edge of Lake Tuscaloosa contains gravestones dating back to 1819.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept a Declaration of Vacation and to adopt a resolution assenting to the vacation of certain property designated as "Right-of-Way to Be Abandoned" containing 0.82 acre, and as described in the attached exhibit. This property is near Smith's Marina.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to appropriate \$270,000 for each Commission District in the 2006-07 Tuscaloosa County budget for Little League Park Development. These funds

will be allocated through Tuscaloosa County Park and Recreation Authority. Projects approved under this program include lighting and grounds work at Northside Baseball Park and a concession building and pavilion at Kentuck Baseball Park.

Commissioner Don Wallace's motion, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, to appropriate \$150,000 for a multi-purpose building at Flatwoods Elementary School, contingent upon the City of Northport committing the same amount, failed on a two-two tie vote. Commissioner Bobby Miller and Commissioner Gary Youngblood cast the NAY votes.

Upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to (one) erect 4-WAY STOP signs at the intersection of 6th Street East and 41st Avenue East, and (two) erect 3-WAY STOP signs at the intersection of 6th Street East and 42nd Avenue East.

Upon recommendation by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into an agreement with Detention Services, a local company, to operate the Tuscaloosa County Juvenile Detention Center. This agreement, effective November 1, 2006, is for the remainder of this fiscal year and the next fiscal year ending September 30, 2008.






Commissioner Don Wallace made a petition with twenty-one signatures requesting that Sunrise Drive be graded a part of the official record.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, November 1, 2006.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE VACATION OF A PUBLIC STREET
IN TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA**

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission is desirous of vacating a portion of a public street located in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama generally known as "Old Columbus Highway" and more particularly described below.

WHEREAS, a duly advertised and noticed public hearing to address this proposed vacation was held on October 18, 2006.

WHEREAS, it appears to the Tuscaloosa County Commission that the vacation of the portion of said public road as herein described will not deprive other property owners of their right, as they may have, to convenient and reasonable means of ingress and egress to and from their property, nor will it adversely affect the interest of the public in any way.

WHEREAS, it appears to the Tuscaloosa County Commission that it is in the interest of the public that the portion of Old Columbus Highway be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION as follows:

That the assent of said County Commission be, and the same is hereby given, to the vacation of the following described portion of a public street in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, to-wit:

That portion of Old Columbus Highway located within the following described property:

Commence at the center of Section 4, T21S, R11W, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, thence S85°-10'-49"W, along said ½ section line, 595.41 feet to an iron pin said point being the point of beginning; thence continue S85°-10'-49"W along said ½ section line 687.71 feet to an iron pin; thence N29°-07'-24"E, 1413.69 feet to an iron pin on the south right of way of U.S. Highway No. 82, (250 feet ROW); thence S60°-45'-30"E, along said right of way, 575.76 feet to an iron pin; thence S29°-24'55"W, 1028.52 feet to the point of beginning. The above-described property lies in the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 4, T21S, R11W, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, and contains 16.1 acres, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following persons or entities are owner(s) of the lots or parcels of land abutting the portion of said street being vacated by this resolution: Faye Henderson Johnson.





RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Public Health and the Alabama Public Health Care Authority are supervising and administering a Phase II Building Program and are in the process of developing and constructing new public health care facilities in many counties in the State of Alabama, provided the county can make a suitable parcel of land available for the project; and

WHEREAS, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, is in need of a new county health facility to house the public health department's clinical and administrative offices and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Health Department has continued to expand its personnel, its facilities and its programs to meet the growing needs of the people of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Health Department has far outgrown its present building and the present facility has inadequate space to house and provide all the clinical and administrative needs of the Tuscaloosa County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Tuscaloosa County will have their health, welfare and general quality of life enhanced and improved by the construction of a new public health care facility in Tuscaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama owns a parcel of real estate which has been determined to be suitable for the purposes stated hereinabove and which it can make available for the construction of a new public health care facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tuscaloosa County Commission that for and in consideration of The Alabama Public Health Care Authority constructing a new health building and health facility to meet present and future clinical and administrative health needs of the citizens of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, at no cost to the Tuscaloosa County Commission, that subject to the conditions and limitations set forth herein below, a parcel of land now owned by Tuscaloosa County, Alabama be deeded to the Alabama Public Health Care Authority, said property being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth fully herein, to-wit:

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Tuscaloosa County Commission that W. Hardy McCollum, its Chairman, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute in the name of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama the Real Estate Transfer Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and the deed, attached hereto as Exhibit "C" to the Alabama Public Health Care Authority as set out in said resolution.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT, WHEREAS, the foregoing Declaration of Vacation has been duly presented by those persons or entities signed thereto, hereinafter sometimes called the Owner, alleging that they own all of the land abutting that portion of a right-of-way in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, which is more particularly described therein; and
