- A. Community Development: \$800.00 to Tuscaloosa County School System for Northside High School FBLA National Conference
- B. Northside Samantha Park Tornado Shelter - Authorize \$81,000 from ARPA Revenue Loss Replacement Funds to PARA for purchase and installation of a Community Safe Room certified for up to 65 persons. This will be installed on the PARA Northside Park grounds next to the existing shelter and utilize existing utilities. Cost estimates include the concrete pad, shelter itself, installation, and utility hookups. Any overages for concrete pad or utility hookups will be paid from District One Community Development funds and will come back before Commission for approval if incurred. Also authorize the Tuscaloosa County Road and Bridge Department to perform site prep work and coordinate as required with PARA on Installation. The Samantha Volunteer Fire Department has agreed by resolution on 5-24-22 to modify the operating agreement for the current shelter to include the new one and to allow hook up to Samantha VFD utilities as required.
