This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to renew a material option with Pat Sharp, Jr.

Exhibit 3-1, Page 04

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept a "Declaration of Vacation of Road" vacating a portion of Old Preacher Lee Road as described in the attached exhibit and to adopt a resolution consenting to the vacation of said right-of-way. The land being vacated is being deeded to Jerry D. Redd and his wife, Renee M. Redd, the owners of the land abutting the former section of Preacher Lee Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize an amendment to Burk-Kleinpeter Inc.'s engineering services contract. Fees for bridge replacement on the Old Fayette Highway will be as follows: basic engineering, \$19,950; topographic survey, \$5,200; and geotechnical engineering, \$7,600. The Halcomb Road Bridge and Sherman Road Bridge will be eliminated from the contract. The net decrease to Burk-Kleinpeter's contract will be \$20,199.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to follow the recommendation by Planning Director Farrington Snipes and authorize the sixteen change orders listed on the attached exhibit 3-4. The change orders on contracts for the Multimodal Warehouse and Bus Station Renovation Project provide a net reduction in cost of \$15,755.52.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to pay Tuscaloosa County expenditures for the month of January, 2000.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for personal computers as follows: 21st Century will provide Computer 1 and Computer 3 on the specification sheet, and MorComp Services will provide Computer 2. The bids were opened on March 1, 2000.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to request proposals on the new road to Englewood Elementary School. According to Commissioner Miller, all of the right-of-way deeds have been signed.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, March 22, 2000.

Know all men by these presents that and in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid to me, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, Pat Sharp, Jr. owner of mineral and surface rights of a certain tract of land hereinafter described, do hereby grant unto TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, acting through the Road and Bridge Department, or its contractor, the right to remove such quantities of material as desired for use in the land, hereinafter described, together with the use of whatever lands are necessary for a convenient temporary right of way between this tract of land and the Project of the duration of this instrument : said tract being approximately described as follows :

Located in Section 8, Township 23N, Range 5E - Hale County

on which land the definite location of the material to be removed has been designated to me; under the following conditions, to wit: Payment for the material removed from the above described land shall be at the rate of .50¢ per cubic yard by loose volume as measured in truck beds at the place of dumping, the record of yardage for payment to me to be the same as made by the County for payment to its hauling contractors or agents and that payment shall be made to me by the County or its contractors, within 30 days after the expiration of each calendar month in which this material was removed, and it is hereby agreed that no payment shall be made to me for any stripping or material necessarily removed in securing suitable contractors, will remove without charge any or all such stripping or material to any spot on my land designated by me, within three hundred (300) feet off the place of excavation, and that the above payment will compensate me in full for any damages to my land incurred in the removal and disposal of these materials.

This option to purchase the right to remove materials in accordance with the terms of this instrument shall be binding upon me, my heirs, assigns, or administrators from the date of its execution to 10/30/1999 - 10/30/2000

I, Pat Sharp, Jr., further stated that I, have the right to give this option and to sell the said material that I (am) (are) am the sole owner of the land (pit) from which the said material is to be taken and that the said land (pit) is free and clear of all liens, mortgages, encumbrances and/or reservations.

DECLARATION OF VACATION OF ROAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Jerry D. Redd and wife, Renee M. Redd, are the owners of all the land abutting a former section of Preacher Lee Road, which is hereinafter more particularly described, and which said property owners desire to vacate as provided in Section 23-4-20 Code of Alabama (1975). The vacation of said road as hereinafter described will not deprive other property owners of reasonable means of ingress and egress to and from their property, nor will it adversely affect the interest of the general public in any way. The County has recently removed the culvert located at the intersection of former Preacher Lee Road and Columbus Road. Due to this action, the former Preacher Lee Road now dead ends before reaching Columbus Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-4-20 Code of Alabama (1975), the undersigned owners do hereby declare vacated that certain portion of Preacher Lee Road encompassed by the following-described parcels of property and as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto:

Parcel One:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, and part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, all lying in Township 20 South, Range 11 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the southeast corner of said Section 7; thence run northwardly and along the east line of said Section 7, 557.02 feet to the Point of Beginning, said point lying on the east right-of-way of the Upper Columbus Road, said right-of-way being measured 40 feet from centerline; thence continue northwardly and along said east line 422.30 feet; thence with an interior angle right of 267 degrees, 00 minutes, run eastwardly 869.99 feet; thence with an interior angle right of 93 degrees, 00 minutes, run northwardly 693.00 feet; thence with an interior angle right of 87 degrees, 00 minutes, run westwardly 870.00 feet; thence with an interior angle right of 182 degrees, 10 minutes, run westwardly 468.00 feet to a point on the southeast right-of-way of Jackson Trace Road; thence with an interior angle right of 135 degrees, 36 minutes, run southwestwardly and along said right-of-way 289.90 feet to a point on the north right-of-way of Upper Columbus Road, said right-of-way measuring 40 feet from centerline; thence with an interior angle right of 98 degrees, 34 minutes, run southeastwardly and along said right-of-way a chord distance of 1125.41 feet to the Point of Beginning, thus making a closing

interior angle right of 36 degrees, 40 minutes. Said Parcel containing 22.20 acres, more or less.

Parcel Two:

Part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 11 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a 2 inch iron pipe found, being accepted as the southwest corner of said Section 8; thence run northwardly and along the west boundary of said Section 8, 557.30 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set at the intersection of the north right-of-way of Upper Columbus Road, said point being the Point of Beginning; thence continue northwardly and along the west boundary of said Section 8, 422.14 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found; thence with an interior angle left of 92 degrees, 59 minutes, 26 seconds, run eastwardly 870.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found; thence with an interior angle left of 86 degrees, 58 minutes, 29 seconds, run southwardly 120.83 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set on the north right-of-way of Preacher Lee Road; thence with an interior angle left of 112 degrees, 17 minutes, 35 seconds, run southwestwardly and along the north right-of-way of Preacher Lee Road 605.22 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set; thence with an interior angle left of 179 degrees, 12 minutes, 51 seconds, run southwestwardly and along the north right-of-way of said Preacher Lee Road 330.21 feet to a point on the curving east right-of-way of said Upper Columbus Road, said right-of-way curving to the left, and having a property line radius of 2,110.93 feet; thence with an interior angle left of 89 degrees, 43 minutes, 07 seconds, run northwestwardly and along said curving east right-of-way, a chord distance of 3.68 feet to the Point of Beginning, thus making a closing interior angle left of 158 degrees, 48 minutes, 31 seconds.

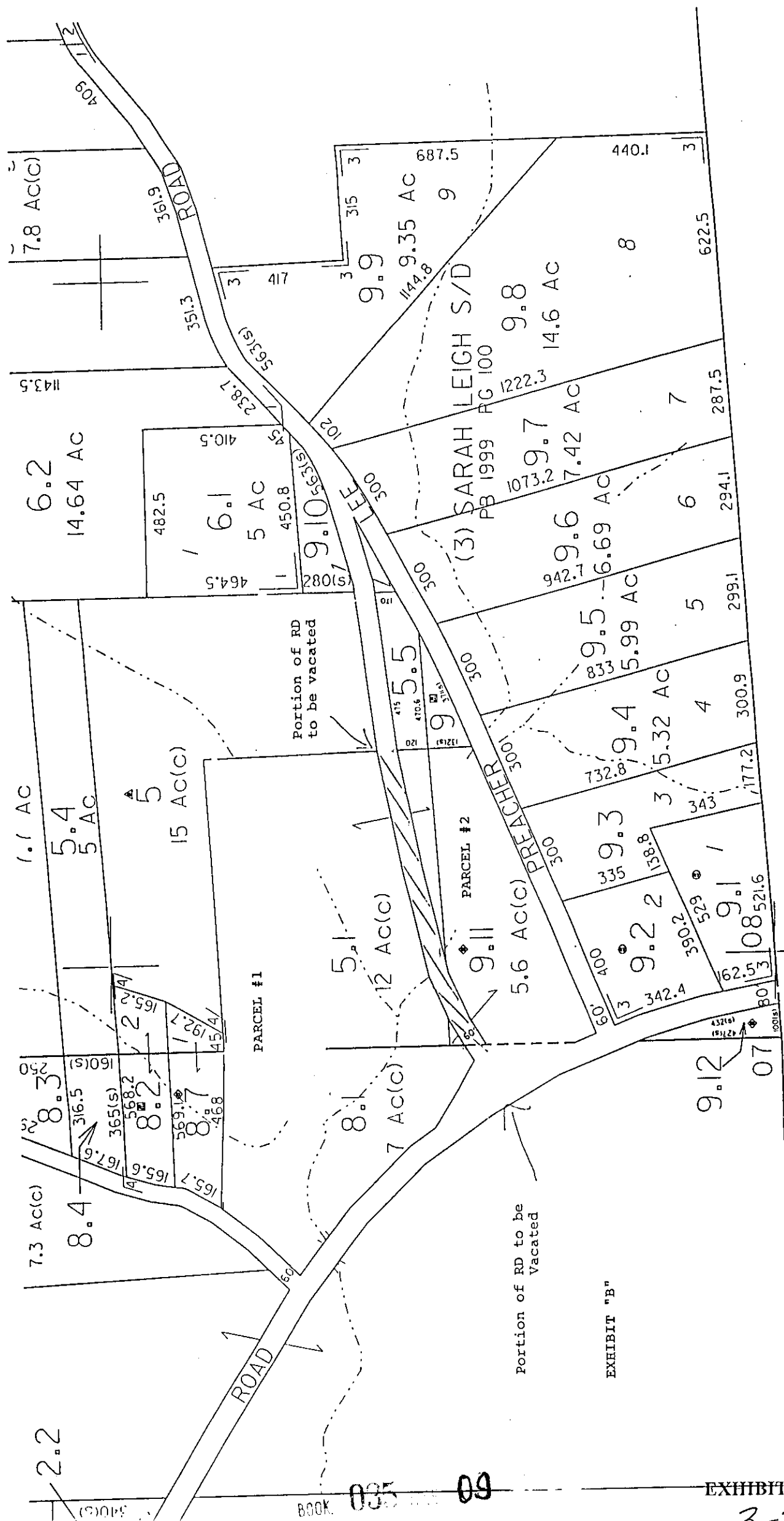

RESOLUTION OF THE

CONSENTING TO VACATION OF RIGHT OF WAY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

WHEREAS, the foregoing declaration has been duly presented by those persons or entities signed thereto, hereinafter sometimes called the "Owner", alleging that they own all of the land abutting that portion of a right-of-way in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, which is more particularly described therein; and

WHEREAS, the described right-of-way lies within the limits of the County of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and the assent of the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the governing body of the County, to the vacation of that certain portion of the right-of-way has been requested and desired by the Owner; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Tuscaloosa County Commission that the vacation of the described portion of the right-of-way will not deprive other property owners of their right as they may have to convenient and reasonable means of ingress and egress to and from their property nor will it adversely affect the interest of the public in any way,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tuscaloosa County Commission as follows:

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Commence at a 2 inch iron pipe found, being accepted as the southwest corner of said Section 8; thence run northwardly and along the west boundary of said Section 8, 557.30 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set at the intersection of the north right-of-way of Upper Columbus Road, said point being the Point of Beginning; thence continue northwardly and along the west boundary of said Section 8, 422.14 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found; thence with an interior angle left of 92 degrees, 59 minutes, 26 seconds, run eastwardly 870.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found; thence with an interior angle left of 86 degrees, 58 minutes, 29 seconds, run southwardly 120.83 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set on the north right-of-way of Preacher Lee Road; thence with an interior angle left of 112 degrees, 17 minutes, 35 seconds, run southwestwardly and along the north right-of-way of Preacher Lee Road 605.22 feet to a 1/2 inch capped rebar set; thence with an interior angle left of 179 degrees, 12 minutes, 51 seconds, run southwestwardly and along the north right-of-way of said Preacher Lee Road 330.21 feet to a point on the curving east right-of-way of said Upper Columbus Road, said right-of-way curving to the left, and having a property line radius of 2,110.93 feet; thence with an interior angle left of 89 degrees, 43 minutes, 07 seconds, run northwestwardly and along said curving east right-of-way, a chord distance of 3.68 feet to the Point of Beginning, thus making a closing interior angle left of 158 degrees, 48 minutes, 31 seconds.

DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS
March 8, 2000

District 1:

Applicant: Buhl Community Park

Amount: \$3,630.85

For: Purchase of playground equipment, crossties, pebbles or sand, and installation of equipment at the community playground, Buhl Elementary School campus. The PTA and community will match primarily with cash.

Applicant: Warrior Baseball

Amount: \$6,869.15

For: Fencing improvements as outlined in the scope of work on the attached low quote from Birmingham Fence. Warrior Baseball will match and make up the difference with cash.

District 2:

Applicant: Vance PTA and Community

Amount Requested: \$8,900

For: Frames, backboards, goals, and installation of two basketball goals at the Vance Activity Building on the elementary school campus. Attached is a quote from Garner & Associates for the proposed work. The building will serve students at the school and the community as a center for various activities. The match will be made by in-kind work and donations as shown in the attached budget.

Applicant: Holt Little League

Amount Requested: \$3,000
