This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to come under the provisions of Section 2 of Act 809 of the regular session of the 2000 Alabama Legislature. This action provides a four percent cost of living raise for Tuscaloosa County retirees at a cost of \$98,000 per year to Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Bobby Miller informed the news media that Tuscaloosa County's annual auction of surplus road equipment will begin at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, September 28th at the County Shop; and the surplus office equipment will be auctioned off at the corner of Lurleen Wallace Blvd. South and 7th Street at 2:00 p.m. on the same day.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to prepare specifications to seek bids on eleven to thirteen new triaxle dump trucks. The bid

will give an option on the delivery date of ninety days or one hundred and eighty days.

Commisisoner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to pay Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the month of August, 2000.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the submission of a proposed application seeking grant funds under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program through the Bureau of Justice Assistance. This continuation grant provides funds to purchase equipment for the Sheriff's Office. This \$138,762.50 grant requires a ten percent cash match.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the Sheriff's Office's selection of Chism Communications for communications radios. The bids were opened on August 2, 2000.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution authorizing the execution of a credit guaranty agreement in connection with the Tuscaloosa County Park and Recreation Authority's issuance of \$3,000,000 Revenue Bonds, Series 2000. These funds are to be used to finance the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a golf course, clubhouse, and maintenance facility (the Bond-Financed Facilities) for the Authority.






There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 27, 2000.

**RESOLUTION OF THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING
THE EXECUTION OF A CREDIT GUARANTY AGREEMENT IN CONNECTION
WITH THE ISSUANCE BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY PARK AND RECREATION
AUTHORITY OF \$3,000,000 REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2000**

WHEREAS, The Tuscaloosa County Park and Recreation Authority, an Alabama public corporation (the "Authority"), has duly authorized the issuance of its \$3,000,000 aggregate principal amount of Revenue Bonds, Series 2000 (the "Series 2000 Bonds") pursuant to a Trust Indenture (the "Indenture") dated September 1, 2000;

WHEREAS, the Series 2000 Bonds are being issued for the purpose of financing the acquisition, construction and equipping of a golf course, clubhouse and maintenance facility (the "Bond-Financed Facilities") for the Authority;

WHEREAS, AmSouth Bank, an Alabama banking corporation (the "Bank"), has issued an irrevocable letter of credit in favor of Regions Bank, an Alabama banking corporation (the "Trustee") to provide for payment of debt service on the Series 2000 Bonds and payment of the purchase price of the Series 2000 Bonds tendered for purchase pursuant to the optional or mandatory tender provisions of the Indenture. The initial letter of credit delivered to the Trustee and any substitute letter of credit delivered pursuant to the Indenture are referred to as the "Letter of Credit";

WHEREAS, the initial Letter of Credit has been issued by the Bank pursuant to a Credit Agreement dated September 1, 2000 (the "Credit Agreement") between the Bank and the Authority whereby the Authority has agreed, among other things, to reimburse the Bank for all amounts drawn pursuant to the initial Letter of Credit;

WHEREAS, the obligations of the Authority to the Bank under the Credit Agreement will be secured by a Credit Guaranty Agreement dated September 1, 2000 (the "Credit Guaranty Agreement") executed by Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama (the "County"), in favor of the Bank;

WHEREAS, the Bonds shall be limited obligations of the Authority payable solely out of (a) revenues of the Authority from the Bond-Financed Facilities, and (b) money received by the Trustee from draws on the Letter of Credit; the Trustee will not have a mortgage on or security interest in the Facilities;

WHEREAS, the Bonds will be purchased by Regions Investment Company, Inc. (the "Underwriter") on the terms and conditions contained in a bond purchase agreement (the "Bond Purchase Agreement") between the Authority and the Underwriter;

WHEREAS, a preliminary official statement (the "Preliminary Official Statement") describing the terms and conditions of the Series 2000 Bonds and the related financing documents has been prepared for distribution to the purchasers of the Series 2000 Bonds; the Authority and the Bank will complete a final Official Statement (the "Official Statement"), which shall be substantially in the form of the Preliminary Official Statement, with additions and changes necessary to reflect the pricing terms set out in the Bond Purchase Agreement;

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the setting of interest rates with respect to the Series 2000 Bonds and the remarketing of the Series 2000 Bonds to be purchased pursuant to the optional or mandatory tender provisions of the Indenture, the Authority and Regions Investment Company, Inc. (the "Remarketing Agent") will enter into a remarketing agreement (the "Remarketing Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, copies of the proposed Indenture, Credit Agreement, Credit Guaranty Agreement, Bond Purchase Agreement, Remarketing Agreement, and Preliminary Official Statement (herein collectively referred to as the "Financing Documents") have been presented to, considered and approved by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION, as follows:

1. The County does hereby approve, authorize, ratify and confirm (a) the execution and delivery of the Credit Guaranty Agreement, and (b) the consummation of all other transactions described in the recitals to this resolution and contemplated by the Financing Documents (the "Plan of Financing").

2. The Chairman of the County Commission is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Credit Guaranty Agreement in substantially the form presented to the County with such changes or additions thereto or deletions therefrom as the officer executing the same shall approve, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by his execution of such instruments. The Chairman of the County Commission is hereby authorized and directed to affix the seal of the County to such instruments and to attest the same.

3. The Chairman of the County Commission and any person or persons designated and authorized by any officer of the County to act in the name and on behalf of the County, or any one or more of them, are authorized to do and perform or cause to be done and performed in the name and on behalf of the County such other acts, to execute and deliver or cause to be executed and delivered in the name and on behalf of the County such other notices, requests, demands, directions, consents, approvals, orders, applications, certificates, agreements, further assurances, or other instruments or communications, under the corporate seal of the County, or otherwise, as they or any of them may deem necessary, advisable, or appropriate in order to (a) complete the Plan of Financing, and (b) carry into effect the intent of the provisions of this resolution and the Financing Documents.

4. Each act of any officer or officers of the County or any person or persons designated and authorized to act by any officer of the County, which act would have been authorized by the foregoing provisions of this resolution except that such action was taken prior to the adoption of this resolution, is hereby ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.
