This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the County Engineer's selection of the following firms as low bidders on the following annual bids:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Planning Department to advertise for bids on Project No. ST-063-888-022. This is a cooperative project with the Alabama Department of Transportation for construction of AASHTO girder bridges at Mill Creek, Tater Hill Creek, and over a Tater Hill tributory on Mitt Lary Road Extension.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the submission of a grant application to the Appalachian Regional Commission requesting \$500,000, which requires a \$500,000 match. This request is being made in an effort to extend sanitary sewer service to some four hundred and ninety nine residents in the Holt Community.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Planning Department to proceed with testing and gathering data for a proposed water project to provide water service to some two hundred and sixty citizens in the Lake Nicol area.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Planning Department to proceed with testing and compiling data for a proposed Prudes Creek area water project in cooperation with Jefferson County. Some of the residents to be served by this proposed project live in Jefferson County.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the payment of \$6,000 from Senator Poole's discretionary funds to FOCUS on SENIOR CITIZENS for the Foster Grandparent Program.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the trucks, cars, construction equipment, and office equipment, etc. listed on the attached exhibit as surplus. But any computers, office equipment, etc. that can be utilized by the school systems will be pulled and transferred to the school systems.

Upon request by Fred Grady, Tuscaloosa County Health Department Administrator, and upon motion by Commissioner Mike Richardson, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum to execute a contract with Ellis Architects, Inc. This contract, dated August 30, 2000, covers architectural services on renovations and additions (\$750,000) to the Tuscaloosa County Health Department.

Forest Ranger Hank McKinley thanked the County Commission for the support in machinery and personnel furnished by Tuscaloosa County to fight a forest fire in northeast Tuscaloosa County last week. The fire consumed some four thousand acres before it was extinguished.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to form a committee consisting of citizens from the Chamber of Commerce, Industrial Development Authority, Home Builders Association, Board of Realtors, financial institutions, and two laymen from each Commissioner's district. The committee is to explore the ramifications of Tuscaloosa County entering the Federal Flood Insurance Program as it relates to zoning, land use, subdivision regulations, building codes, health regulations, etc.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution appointing the Secretary of State to serve as Tuscaloosa County's agent for the purpose of paying postage costs necessary for the mailing of certain notices to voters (reidentification) as required by Act 95-769; and further authorized the Chairperson to execute an agency agreement with the Alabama Secretary of State.

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission is eligible to submit a grant for Federal funding assistance to the Appalachian Regional Commission to secure funding to assist with the construction of a Sanitary Sewer Extension Project to serve approximately 499 residents of the Holt community; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the proposed project will be approximately \$2,959,600.00 for the construction of this project in this distressed or "pocket of poverty area" of Tuscaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, the determination has been made that there exists a serious problem and threat to the health of residents of the Holt Community due to septic tank failures and the presence of raw sewage in the proposed project area and that there is a definite need for a Holt Community Sanitary Sewer Extension Project, Phase II;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tuscaloosa County Commission hereby approves the submission of the subject application in the amount of \$ 500,000.00 to be matched with \$500,000.00 and makes a commitment to proceed with the completion of the proposed project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tuscaloosa County Commission authorizes the Chairman, W. Hardy McCollum, to execute any and all documents as required to provide for the submission and approval of the proposed project.

AGREEMENT

This agreement by and between the Tuscaloosa County Commission ("the Commission") and Focus on Senior Citizens, hereinafter referred to as "the Recipient", becomes effective upon full execution.

Whereas, the Commission has the responsibility for administering the County for the benefit the citizens thereof; and

Whereas, the Recipient is organized to provide and is desirous of providing services beneficial to the general welfare of all citizens of the County.

In consideration of the compensation and covenants contained herein, the Commission and the Recipient mutually agree as follows:

- 1. That the Recipient will provide the following service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County: Volunteer recognition activities for citizens (Foster Grandparent Program).
- 2. That the Recipient will provide the Commission a report on the Recipient's accomplishments at the conclusion of the services provided under this agreement.
- 3. That in consideration of such services the Commission shall pay the Recipient the sum of \$ 6,000 upon full execution of this agreement.
- 4. That the compensation provided in Item 3 above totaling \$ 6,000 shall be the total cost of this agreement to the Commission.
- 5. That this agreement can be terminated by either party on giving thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party.
 - 6. That this contract shall constitute the entire agreement of the parties, and any amendments to its terms must be in writing.

The _________ County Commission hereby authorizes the Secretary of State for the State of Alabama to act as its agent for the purposes of paying postage necessary for the mailing of certain notices to voters as required by Act 95-769 and collecting reimbursements from the State Elections Fund associated with compliance with Act 95-769. The County Commission understands that the Secretary of State will essentially be paying postage on the voter notification required by §17-4-201, Code of Alabama (1975) for which the Commission will be obligated to reimburse the Secretary of State by this agreement and that such reimbursement shall occur from monies the County is entitled to for such costs from the State Elections Fund. The County Commission also understands that the business reply mail account fee and business reply mail postage charges will still be its responsibility for which it may be reimbursed by the State of Alabama under the normal operation of the Act.
