This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a material option with Nisa Moore at a cost of fifty cents per cubic yard.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a material option with M. D. McGee at a price of sixty-five cents per cubic yard.

The expense to Tuscaloosa County will be ES&S's charge for setting up and servicing said machines for this election.

of Tuscaloosa County entering the federal subsidized flood insurance program. The Tuscaloosa County Commission will be invited to attend all meetings of said committee.
