This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Reginald Murray

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to waive the fifty foot right-of-way requirement for a section of Medders Road to facilitate improvement of said road.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for earthwork and related construction on Hulsey Road and Bristol Drive to Tomlin Construction LLC. The Engineering Department elected to deduct Alternate 1 and Item 401A-001 for a net bid of \$88,622.94. The bids were opened August 28, 2002.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for water relocation on Hulsey Road and Bristol Drive to Fairchild Construction. The bids were opened August 28, 2002.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to proceed with legal action against AT&T to have AT&T lines moved on Hulsey Road to facilitate improving said road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize condemnation, if necessary, in order to acquire the necessary rights-of-way on Myers Road to facilitate improving said road.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 11, 2002.
