This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Chairman to execute an agreement with the State of Alabama, acting by and through the Alabama Department of Transportation, to cooperate in the construction of a 3@85' span AASHTO girder bridge on Bull Slough Road over North River.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the execution of a material option with Tony Wheat at 65¢ per cubic yard.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a speed limit of 35 MPH on House Bend Road.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a speed limit of 25 MPH on Price Road.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for reinforcing steel to Alabama Gate City Steel Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened August 28, 2002.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to clean out the ditch from the city's concrete flume to the edge of the trees on property adjacent to The Glenn. Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted two to nothing, with Commissioner Mike Richardson abstaining, to add the Preacher Lee Road Water Expansion Project (Sand Springs Water Authority) to the County-wide Water Extension Project list, and to amend McGiffert and Associate Inc.'s contract to include the design of said project.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the expenditure of \$942.64 of Representative Gerald Allen's discretionary funds to the Duncanville Volunteer Fire Department.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a contract with The Valuation Advisory Group, Inc. to value all county assets in order for Tuscaloosa County to comply with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and GASB Statement No. 34.







**AGREEMENT**

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the STATE OF ALABAMA, acting by and through the ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, party of the first part (hereinafter called the State), and TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA (FEIN 63 6001719), party of the second part (hereinafter called the County):

**WITNESSETH**

WHEREAS, the State and County desire to cooperate in the construction of a 3 @ 85' span AASHTO girder bridge on Bull Slough Road over North River. BIN 011916. Length - 0.053 mile. Project No. ACGBBR-7932(600), TCP 63-01-01. CPMS Ref. # 100042447.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the State and County as follows;

- A. The County will furnish all Right-of-Way for project without cost to the State or this Project.
- B. The County will adjust and/or relocate all Utilities on the project without cost to the State or this Project.
- C. The County will make the survey, complete the plans and furnish all preliminary engineering for the project with County forces without cost to the State or this Project. The plans will be subject to the approval of the State and the project will be constructed in accordance with the plans approved by the State and the terms of this Agreement.
- D. The County will furnish all construction engineering for the project with County forces. The cost of the construction engineering shall be included as part of the construction cost for the project.
- E. The State will furnish the necessary inspection and testing of materials when needed as part of the cost of the project.
- F. Funding for this Agreement is subject to availability of Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds at the time of authorization. The State will not be liable for Federal Aid funds or State funds in any amount. Any deficiency in Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds, or overrun in constructions costs will be borne by the County from the County's allocation of Federal Garvee Bond funds and Amendment One State Matching Bond funds, if available, or from County funds.
- G. The estimated cost of construction of this project payable by the parties is the amount set forth below:

Federal GARVEE Bond Funds	\$ 583,040.00
General Obligation Bond Funds	<u>145,760.00</u>
Total (Incl. E & I)	\$ 728,800.00
- H. The State will be responsible for advertisement and receipt of bids, and the award of the Contract. Following the receipt of bids and prior to the award of the Contract, the State will invoice the County for its prorata share of the estimated cost as reflected by the bid of the successful bidder plus E & I, and the County will pay this amount to the State no later than 30 days after the date bids are opened.
- I. The County will submit reimbursement invoices for work performed under the terms of this Agreement to the Alabama Department of Transportation within six (6) months after the completion and acceptance of the project. Any invoices submitted after this six (6) month period will not be eligible for payment.
- J. The County will comply with the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2002 Edition, on this project and will ensure that alignment and grades on this project meet the standards of the Alabama Department of Transportation and the project will be built in accordance with the approved plans.
- K. An audit report must be filed with the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, upon receipt by the County, for any audit performed on this project in accordance with Act No. 94-414.

L. Upon completion and acceptance of this project, the County will maintain the project in satisfactory condition in accordance with the requirements of the Alabama Department of Transportation.

O. This Agreement will terminate January 1, 2003 for project if project has not been authorized to be let to contract.

It is agreed that the terms and commitments contained herein shall not be constituted as a debt of the State of Alabama in violation of Article 11, Section 213 of the Constitution of Alabama, 1901, as amended by Amendment Number 26. It is further agreed that if any provision of this Agreement shall contravene any statute or Constitutional provision of amendment, either now in effect or which may, during the course of this Agreement, be enacted, then the conflicting provision in the Agreement shall be deemed null and void.

**TERMINATION DUE TO INSUFFICIENT FUNDS:**

If the Agreement term is to exceed more than one fiscal year, then said Agreement is subject to termination in the event that funds should not be appropriated for the continued payment of the Agreement in subsequent fiscal years.

In the event of proration of the fund from which payment under this Agreement is to be made, Agreement will be subject to termination.

**ADR CLAUSE:**

For any and all disputes arising under the terms of this contract, the parties hereto agree, in compliance with the recommendation of the Governor and Attorney General, when considering settlement of such disputes, to utilize appropriate forms of non-binding alternative dispute resolution including, but not limited to, mediation by and through the Attorney General Office of Administrative hearings or where appropriate, private mediators.

The County or its contractor(s) will remove without charge any or all such stripping or material to any spot on the land designated by the undersigned, within three hundred (300) feet of the place of excavation, and that the above payment will compensate the undersigned in full for any damages to the land incurred in the removal and disposal of these materials.

This option to purchase the right to remove materials in accordance with the terms of this instrument shall be binding upon the undersigned, the undersigned heirs, assigns, or administrators from the date of its execution for a period of 9/11/2002 - 9/11/2003

The undersigned authorized representative(s) hereby further state(s) that they have the right to give this option and to sell the said material and that the said land (pit) is free and clear of all liens, mortgages, encumbrances and/or reservations.

and furniture and fixtures.

Land and vehicles will be included based on a verification of information to be provided by County personnel.

Buildings and improvements other than buildings will be included based on a combination of verifying existing records and performing accepted appraisal techniques. In performing our analysis of the historical costs of these assets, we will work with the County's existing records where possible. In assigning historical costs to these assets, we feel that it is important to utilize actual costs, where these costs are available. 





**RESOLUTION 2002-201**

**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 201, 195  
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING 5-MIL AD VALOREM TAX WITHIN THE TOWN OF  
BROOKWOOD**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Brookwood (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Brookwood") has begun to grow at a very rapid pace; and

**WHEREAS**, Brookwood has sought to improve its infrastructure by providing sewer services, expanding water lines, the construction of roads, and other improvements for the benefit of the health, welfare and safety of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Brookwood has previously discussed the increase and/or imposition of ad valorem taxes within the Town of Brookwood at the following meetings of the City Council of the Town of Brookwood:

- 1. June 5, 2001
- 2. June 19, 2001
- 3. July 10, 2001
- 4. July 17, 2001
- 5. August 7, 2001
- 6. September 11, 2001

**WHEREAS**, Brookwood having given proper notice of these proceedings by posting notice of the meetings at the regular place of positing for the Town Council agenda; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved that:

1. Brookwood desires to impose a 5-mil Ad Valorem Tax (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Tax") on all real and personal property, including vehicles of any type, located within the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood. Such tax shall be administered as set forth below, and shall be subject to those limitations set forth below.

2. By adoption of this Resolution, the Town Council of the Town of Brookwood, establishes an Ad Valorem Tax in the amount of 5-mil on all real and personal property, including vehicles of any type, located within the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood.

3. By delivery of this Resolution to the Tuscaloosa County Tax Assessor's office, such Assessor has been notified, as required by Section 11-51-42 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, of the levy of a 5 mil Ad Valorem tax on all personal and real property located within the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood.

4. Such Tax Assessor shall, pursuant to Section 11-51-47 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, maintain such appropriate records and books so that all property subject to such Tax shall be showed and will allow for such property's value to be extended for each succeeding year.

5. Such Tax Assessor shall further compute and cause an entry to be made in the appropriate ledger and books of the amount of the Tax owned by each taxpayer pursuant to Section 11-51-48 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.

6. The Tuscaloosa County Tax Collector shall begin collecting that amount certified by the Tax Assessor as owed, by each individual and entity, by reason of the levy of the Ad Valorem tax set forth in this resolution. Such collection shall begin on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2003.

7. As required by Section 11-51-50, the Ad Valorem tax levied herein, shall be subject to the procedures and enforcement of collection as shall apply to the collection of state and county taxes. Such limitations shall include any and all exemptions and exclusions from such tax as set forth in the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, the Alabama Constitution, the United States constitution, or other valid and enforceable law or rule of the Federal Government, State of Alabama government, or legal agency thereof.

Any exemptions from ad valorem taxes currently granted by the State of Alabama, or Tuscaloosa County, shall equally apply to the levy of ad valorem taxation set forth in this resolution. This shall include, but not be limited to, the homestead exemption, the over-sixty-five exemption, the exemption for disabled persons, and any other exemption as provided by Alabama Code Sections 40-9-1 through 40-9-31 as amended.

8. Such Tax Collector shall submit to the Town Council of the Town of Brookwood a monthly report. Such report shall set forth the taxes collected for the preceding month. Such Tax Collector shall also submit to the treasurer of the Town of Brookwood all tax amounts collected which are due to the Town of Brookwood. Such report and payment of tax amounts due shall be made in accordance with Section 11-51-52 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended. Such Tax Collector shall also make a final settlement, under oath, with the Town of Brookwood; as part of such final settlement the Tax Collector shall make a final distribution of all amounts owed to the Town of Brookwood.

9. Such Tax Assessor and Collector shall be required to perform any and all other functions, not specifically listed here, required by the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, the Constitution of the State of Alabama, any United States federal law, the United States Constitution, and any and

all other rules, laws, ordinances, or otherwise by the United States Government, the State of Alabama Government, and any agency or extension thereof.

10. The Ad Valorem Tax levied by reason of this Resolution shall be in force from year to year until repealed or amended by the Town Council of the Town of Brookwood.

11. No provision of this Resolution shall be applied so as to impose any unlawful tax or unlawful burden on interstate commerce or on any activity of the State or federal government; or in any manner which is repugnant to or violates any provisions of the United States or Alabama Constitutions.

12. It shall be unlawful for any person connected with the administration of this Resolution to divulge any information obtained by him or her in the course of inspection and examination of the books of account, invoices, bank statements, sales tax records, state and federal income tax records, or other reports and memoranda of the taxpayer made pursuant to the provisions hereof, except to the Mayor, the Town Council, the Town Clerk, the Town Attorney, or their agents or representatives connected with the administration of this resolution, or pursuant to court proceedings or process.

13. The adoption of this Resolution shall not abridge the right of the Council of the Town of Brookwood to change, alter, increase, decrease or revoke any of the said resolution at any time.

15. Should any section or provision of this Resolution for any reason be held void or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of any other section or provision thereof which is not itself void or invalid, it being the purpose and intention of the Town Council to enact each separate section and/or subsection separately.
