This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of October 19, 2022.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Sandy Ridge, Phase I, District III.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission and approve a subdivision regulation waiver request for River Point, Phase 2, Resurvey of lots 8-10 and 84-85, District III.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve bidding the Wallace Ferry Road resurfacing project, in conjunction with receiving an ALDOT Industrial Access Grant up to half the cost of the project, estimated grant amount to be \$1,041,000.00.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss a matter.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle's motion to accept Booler Road into the County Road Maintenance Program was seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker. After discussion, Commissioner Jerry Tingle withdrew his motion.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, November 16, 2022.
