This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to approve change orders on the Sheriff's Office 35<sup>th</sup> St Building Project was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. After discussion, Commissioner Mark C. Nelson offered an amendment to authorize the Chairman to approve change orders not exceeding 10% per individual contract or 10% of the aggregate contracted amounts, and to require that the Finance Department be notified promptly of any change order approved. Commissioner Reginald Murray accepted the amendment, which was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. The motion as amended passed unanimously.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an amendment to the rules of procedure for the Tuscaloosa County Commission to require a First Read Review on the Agenda for all public fund expenditures exceeding \$250,000.00.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize construction of the Fosters Farmer's Market building in the amount of \$42,147.00, for the building, plumbing and electrical work.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to proceed with researching details to complete the Courthouse renovations.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider a drainage project at the Metro Animal Shelter.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Public Works to fix the drainage issue at the Metro Animal Shelter's dog yard in the rear of the building in an amount up to \$8,000.00 split evenly between all four (4) district's community development funds.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, March 22, 2023.
