This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of July 10, 2024.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss a legal matter.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to amend the FY24 general fund budget in the amount of \$55,000.00 to pave the Sheriff's Office Shooting Range access road and parking area. The Sheriff's Office is funding \$60,000.00 for a total project cost of \$115,000.00.

County Engineer Scott Anders presented the County Commission the Rebuild Alabama Contractors Report for FY2024.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for June 2024.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin condemnation proceedings on 16482 Hwy 11N, District II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 90-day request for extension of demolition on 14113 Snider Rd, District II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 60-day request for extension of demolition on 20367 Pleasant Grove Rd, District II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 90-day request for extension of demolition on 19489 Judge Parsons Rd, District II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 90-day request for extension of demolition on 1021 38th Ave NE, District II.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 60-day request for extension of demolition on 10972 Propst Rd, District III.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle's motion to approve a resolution of demolition on 2 Ridge Ave, District II, was seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray. After discussion, Commissioner Jerry Tingle withdrew his motion due to the owner working on the property and tabled the agenda item.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 16141 Sylvan Loop Rd, District IV, from the Public Nuisance/Demolition list.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 1409 Crescent Ridge Rd, District II, from the Public Nuisance/Demolition list.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to fix the cost of demolition and file a lien in the amount of \$7,119.63 on 11 Stevenson Dr, District II, and remove the property from the Public Nuisance /Demolition list.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District III community development fund in the amount of \$12,500.00 to stripe the Taylorville Primary School parking lot.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District III community development fund in the amount of \$27,517.00 to resurface the Hillcrest High School tennis courts.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District I and District IV community development funds in the amount of \$4,300.00 (\$2,150.00 each) for the Buhl Elementary School playground mulch.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District I and District IV community development funds in the amount of \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 each) to the Sipse Valley VFD for truck unit #500, declared surplus July 10, 2024.

The Commission retired into Executive Session and did not reconvene.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 7, 2024.
