This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of July 24, 2024.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider meeting date changes.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to change the regularly scheduled County Commission Meeting on August 21, 2024 to be held on August 14, 2024, with a budget work session to follow.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Resurvey of Green Acres Estates Sector One, District II.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an agreement with Hale County to resurface a portion of Simpson Swamp Road.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to post a speed limit of 25 MPH on Ralph Cooley Rd.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss contract negotiations and board appointments.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Finance to pay the following ADEM fees related to the County Jail Secure Behavioral Health and Medical Unit site work: property eligibility determination fee in the amount of \$670.00, ADEM voluntary clean-up program application fee in the amount of \$5,060.00, and an assessment report review fee in the amount of \$10,520.00.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 90-day request for extension of demolition on 19540 Walter Shirley Rd, District I.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a 60-day request for extension of demolition on 3701 Clements Rd, District II.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to approve a resolution for demolition on 12405 Fosters Loop Rd, District IV, was seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson. After discussion, Commissioner Murray made a motion to rescind the previous motion to approve a resolution for demolition, and to grant a 90-day extension of demolition. The motion to rescind and grant a 90-day extension on 12405 Fosters Loop Rd was seconded by Commissioner Nelson. The County Commission voted unanimously to approve the motion.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove the following properties from the Public Nuisance/Demolition list:

1803 39<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, District II

4611 17<sup>th</sup> St NE, District II

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a request by Southland Resources, Inc, to vacate and relocate a portion of Camp Cherry Austin Road, District II, in relation to their mining project. Commissioner Tingle also stated the new road is to be built to County regulations and Rocky Branch Rd from Hwy 216 to the new Camp Cherry Austin Road is to be paved. The County Commission voted unanimously to approve the motion.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District II community development fund in the amount of \$1,000.00 to the Antioch Fire Department for truck unit #202, declared surplus July 10, 2024.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District III community development fund in the amount of \$1,950.00 to Hillcrest High Booster Club for a pre-game meal.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District III community development fund in the amount of \$14,919.20 to PHE for Hillcrest High School Drainage Project. Exhibit 8-5, Page

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District III and District IV community development funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 (\$5,000.00 each) for the Lloyd Wood Education Center basketball court construction.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure from the District IV community development fund in the amount of \$19,000.00 to Sipse Valley High School for a digital sign.

The Commission retired into Executive Session.

Following Executive Session, Chairman Ward D. "Rob" Robertson called the Commission back to order.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Ms. Lyda Black and Mr. Ken Swindle to the Department of Human Resources (DHR) Board. Their terms will expire September 1, 2030.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Ms. Kristi Moore (County appointee) and Mr. Bruce Henderson (joint County/City appointee - to be ratified by the City of Tuscaloosa) to the Tuscaloosa County Port Authority. Their terms will expire August 26, 2029.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to seek an appraisal on a parcel to be considered for future County use.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 14, 2024.
