Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of August 7, 2024.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the 2025 Rebuild Alabama County Transportation Plan as presented by County Engineer Scott Anders.
