This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of September 3, 2025.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into Executive Session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss personnel matters, possible litigation and Park and Recreation Authority (PARA) Board Appointment.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution for the Alabama Simplified Sellers Use Tax (SSUT) opposing legislative changes that would disrupt the SSUT program's operations or call the program's constitutionality into question.

Commission Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart

from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss the bid for the Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) Repair project at the Synergic Center.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the winning bid for replacing the Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) in the amount of \$203,254.00 to Marathon Electric.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to table the waiver request for Lot 2 Moore Division - Plat Book 2022 page 26 until next meeting.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to submit the 2026 Tuscaloosa County Rebuild Alabama County Transportation Plan to the State.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss a change in the Waste Management fee.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to increase the bulk pick up fee from Waste Management to Tuscaloosa County from \$2.24 to \$3.00 per month. The increase of .76 cents would help cover the additional Grapple Truck and fund the Solid Waste Department.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize reallocation of \$51,000.00 from the remaining contract with West Alabama Works for ARPA Project #5077 Ignite & Building Hope Programs due to project being completed under budget.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize an Amendment to Inter-Agency Agreement (IAA) to allocate unused District III ARPA funds in the amount of \$51,000.00 as discussed above and an additional \$16,535.40 from an expired contract with West Alabama Food Bank for Facility renovations to support Project #5065 Duncanville Volunteer Fire Department for a total of \$67,535.40.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize reallocation of remaining ARPA funds in the amount of \$18,660.00 from Project #5082 Dale Drive Water Line, due to the project being completed under budget, to be applied to ARPA Project #5078 Hosmer Road Waterline Project with Warrior River Water Authority.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for August 2025 in the amount of \$11,375,722.48.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding request in the amount of \$2,500.00 from the District II Discretionary account to the Holt High School Carpenter Program.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding request in the amount of \$28,077.64 from the District III Community Development fund to the Tuscaloosa County Road and Bridge Department to close out funding for Hillcrest High School drainage and parking lot project.

The commission was addressed by Patricia Williams requesting additional law enforcement presence on and around Camp Cherry Austin Rd due to ATV's riding in the area causing damage to property after Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Deputies were present on Friday - Sunday. Ms. Williams was referred to speak with Chief Deputy Keller about additional law enforcement presence.

The Commission retired into Executive Session.

Following Executive Session, Chairman Ward D. "Rob" Robertson Called the commission back to order.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Curtis Travis to the Tuscaloosa County Park and Recreation (PARA) Authority Board of Directors. The term will expire October 1, 2028.
